3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. I'm going to go
4 ahead and get started. And thank you, everyone
5 for participating in average roll call hearings
6 via online WebEx provided for by the D.C. Office
7 of Open Government.

8 There -- this is the only roll call
9 hearing today. So, I'm just going to call the
10 case.

11 And then next, I will elevate you, so
12 that you have the option to turn on your cameras
13 and your microphones.

14 So, I'm going to take a roll call just
15 so that I can know for sure who is present. Oh,
16 and I should remind everyone to mute your
17 computer if you're not speaking.

18 To mute your computer if you're not
19 speaking, so that the Court Reporter can hear,
20 and we can also hear each other.

21 And I wanted to remind you to announce
22 yourself whenever you speak. So that the Court
23 Reporter knows who's speaking.

24 I'm going to do a roll call so that I
25 can be sure that I know who's present. Jackie

1 Coombe? Ms. Coombe?

2 MS. COOMBE: Yes. Present. Good
3 morning.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Jeff
5 Jackson?

6 MR. JACKSON: Present.

7 MS. FLETCHER: All right. Judith
8 Bunnell?

9 MS. BUNNELL: Present also.

10 MS. FLETCHER: I know that Cookie
11 Cruse is present.

12 MS. CRUSE: Present.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Nicole Vikan?

14 MS. VIKAN: Good morning. I'm
15 present.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Vikan, good
17 morning. Mr. Murphy?

18 MR. MURPHY: Hi there Laverne.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Hey Rick. Thank you.
20 Stephen Lintner?

21 MR. LINTNER: Yes, I am present. Good
22 morning.

23 MS. FLETCHER: You are present. Thank
24 you, good morning. Did I miss anybody?

25 MS. RUTLEDGE: You missed me, Susan

1 Rutledge.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay, thank you,
3 Ms. Rutledge. I know you're here. Thank you.

4 MR. LINTNER: You've also missed
5 another person, Tarleton Watkins.

6 MR. WATKINS: Yeah, I spoke up earlier
7 about the echo. But, hello. I'm Tarleton, and
8 I'm also present.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Hi. I have you. Thank
10 you very much.

11 MR. WATKINS: Thank you. Thank you,
12 Ms. Fletcher.

13 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.
14 Anybody else?

15 (No response)

16 MS. FLETCHER: I'm trying to make sure
17 I didn't miss anybody. I think I have everybody.

18 Okay. Well then, we'll get started.
19 We have several protestants in this case.

20 We have the Citizens Association of
21 Georgetown. They also have standing as a
22 protestant.

23 ANC 2E has standing as a protestant.
24 And then there's a group of 12 represented by
25 you, Ms. Vikan? Ms. Vikan?

1 MS. VIKAN: I guess I can't be heard.
2 Yes, ma'am. Thank you.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, I hear you -- I
4 hear you now. You're representing a group of --
5 you're representing a group of 12.

6 MS. VIKAN: Um-hum.

7 MS. FLETCHER: And there are several
8 individuals from your group present today.

9 MS. VIKAN: Yes, ma'am.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So what I --

11 MS. VIKAN: We have to have at least
12 five, right?

13 MS. FLETCHER: That's a -- that's
14 fine. Yes, at least five will be good.

15 MS. VIKAN: Okay.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Let me -- let me do
17 this before we go any further. For the Court
18 Reporter, I'm going to want you to state your
19 names and spell them for the record.

20 Ms. Cruse, you're representing the
21 Citizens Association of Georgetown?

22 MS. CRUSE: Yes, I am.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Can you state your name
24 and spell it for the record, please?

25 MS. CRUSE: Yes. Karen K-A-R-E-N

1 Cruse C-R-U-S-E.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Mr.
3 Murphy, you're representing ANC 2E?

4 MR. MURPHY: That is correct. It's
5 Rick --

6 (Simultaneous speaking)

7 MS. FLETCHER: Could you please spell
8 --

9 MR. MURPHY: Rick R-I-C-K Murphy M-U-
10 R-P-H-Y. I represent single member district 2E
11 03.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And is it
13 Ms. Vikan? Am I pronouncing that correctly?

14 MS. VIKAN: Yep. Exactly right,
15 correctly the first time.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Could you spell your
17 name -- state your name and spell it for the
18 record, please?

19 MS. VIKAN: Yes, ma'am. It's Nicole
20 Vikan, N-I-C-O-L-E, last name, Vikan, V- as in
21 Victor, I-K-A-N.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
23 And now if each of the individuals present from
24 your group would state their names and spell it
25 for the record.

1 Let's start with, Ms. Coombe, you're
2 with the group of 12, yes?

3 MS. COOMBE: Yes, ma'am.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Could you --

5 (Simultaneous speaking)

6 MS. COOMBE: Jackie J-A-C-K-I-E, last
7 name is Coombe, C- as in Charlie O-O-M- as in
8 Mary, B- as in boy, E- as in Edward.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

10 And --

11 MS. COOMBE: Thank you.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Judith -- Ms. Bunnell,
13 you're part of the group of 12?

14 MS. BUNNELL: Yes, ma'am.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Could you state your
16 name and spell it please?

17 MS. BUNNELL: It's Judith Bunnell, J-
18 U-D-I-T-H B- as in Boston U-N-N-E-L-L.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Mr.
20 Lintner, would you state your name and spell it
21 for the record, please?

22 MR. LINTNER: Stephen Lintner S-T-E-P-
23 H-E-N L-I-N-T-N-E-R, Stephen Lintner.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Ms.
25 Rutledge, if you could do the same?

1 MS. RUTLEDGE: Yes. It's Susan
2 Rutledge, S-U-S-A-N last name Rutledge R- like
3 Robert, U-T- like Tom, L-E-D-G-E.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr.
5 Watkins?

6 MR. WATKINS: Yes. It's Tarleton
7 Watkins, T- as in tango A-R-L-E-T-O-N, last name
8 Watkins W-A-T-K-I-N-S.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very
10 much. Did I le -- did I miss anybody?

11 (No response)

12 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Jackson? Would you
13 state your name and spell it for the record,
14 please?

15 MR. JACKSON: Yes. Jeff Jackson J-E-
16 F-F J-A-C-K-S-O-N.

17 MS. FLETCHER: There are at least five
18 individuals present from the group of 12. And so
19 the group of 12 is grated full standing as a
20 protestant.

21 So we have three protestants, the
22 Citizens Association of Georgetown, ANC 2E, and a
23 group of 12.

24 We need to set a date for a mediation.
25 I'll give you the next available day. The next

1 available day is Thursday, November 19.

2 Yeah, pretty much any time up until
3 2:00 a.m. 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 12:00, 1:00. Is -
4 - we can start with 10:00.

5 MS. VIKAN: Ms. Fletcher?

6 MS. FLETCHER: Yes?

7 MS. VIKAN: Does every --

8 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, who's speaking?

9 (Simultaneous speaking)

10 MS. VIKAN: Oh, I'm sorry.

11 MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry.

12 MS. VIKAN: This is Nicole Vikan.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Hi.

14 MS. VIKAN: Hi. Since I'm new at the
15 process, who needs to be there? Do I -- am I the
16 only one? Or do all, at least five of us need to
17 be there?

18 MS. FLETCHER: Only you, the
19 designated representative.

20 MS. VIKAN: Oh.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh.

22 MS. VIKAN: I'll take as early as
23 possible on the 19th if that works for whomever
24 else is involved. Thank you.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, then on

1 the 19th we can do it at 9:00 or 10:00?

2 MS. VIKAN: 9:00 works for me.

3 MR. MURPHY: Ms. Fletcher, the time --
4 this is Rick Murphy.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Yes?

6 MR. MURPHY: I think I am going to be
7 on an Interstate on the 19th. Which would make
8 it difficult for me to attend.

9 Would it be possible for there to be
10 a date the next week that would work?

11 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. The following
12 week would be, we could make it Monday, November
13 23.

14 MR. MURPHY: That would --
15 (Simultaneous speaking)

16 MS. FLETCHER: And --

17 MR. MURPHY: That would work for me.

18 MS. FLETCHER: That would work?

19 MR. JACKSON: I'll be on travel.

20 That's during the Thanksgiving holiday.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well then so,
22 Mr. Jackson, you're going to be away that entire
23 week?

24 MR. JACKSON: Yes.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. In that case let

1 me see if we can do something earlier the week
2 before. Just a second.

3 We can do Wednesday, November 18.

4 (Simultaneous speaking)

5 MR. MURPHY: Yeah. I believe --

6 MS. VIKAN: I -- I'm sorry.

7 MR. MURPHY: I believe I could do
8 that, Ms. Fletcher.

9 MR. JACKSON: Yeah. That works for me
10 too.

11 MS. VIKAN: I'm so sorry. But I have
12 child care issues on Wednesdays.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

14 MS. VIKAN: Mondays and Thursdays are
15 ideal for me.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Mondays and Thursdays?

17 MS. VIKAN: Yes. If Wednesday needs
18 to happen, I can try to see what I could do. But
19 I can't say right off the bat that it would work.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Well, what about
21 Monday, the 16th?

22 MR. JACKSON: That would work.

23 MS. VIKAN: That's fine with me. I
24 can't speak for others of course.

25 MR. JACKSON: Yeah That works for me

1 also.

2 MS. FLETCHER: 11:00? It would need
3 to be at 11:00 on Monday.

4 MS. VIKAN: That's fine for me.

5 MR. JACKSON: Yeah. That's fine for
6 me.

7 MR. MURPHY: Yeah. I think that will
8 work for me.

9 MS. VIKAN: Monday the 16th, at 11:00.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Is that okay for you,
11 Ms. Cruse?

12 MS. CRUSE: Yes, it is.

13 MS. FLETCHER: So, Ms. Vikan is good.
14 Mr. Murphy is good. Ms. Cruse is good. Okay.
15 That's everyone.

16 So, we'll set it for Monday, November
17 11.

18 MR. MURPHY: You mean 11:00 -- Monday,
19 November 16, correct?

20 MS. FLETCHER: Monday, November 16.
21 I'm sorry, Monday, November 16 at 11:00.

22 So, I don't have dates for the status
23 and the protest hearings today. By the 16th if I
24 have those dates, I'll provide them to you.

25 So, we'll just go ahead and proceed

1 with the -- with the mediation.

2 Any questions at all from anyone?

3 MS. VIKAN: Who is at the mediation,
4 Ms. Fletcher?

5 MS. FLETCHER: Is that Ms. Vikan
6 speaking?

7 MS. VIKAN: Oh, yes. I'm sorry.

8 MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. You will
9 be there. Rick Murphy will be there from ANC 2E.
10 And Karen Cruse will be there from the Citizens
11 Association of Georgetown, and me, I'm the
12 Board's mediator.

13 So, just the four of us.

14 MS. VIKAN: No one from the other --
15 from the folks representing the --

16 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, I'm sorry. Jeff
17 Jackson. Jeff Jackson is representing the
18 establishment.

19 MS. VIKAN: Okay.

20 MS. FLETCHER: So, Mr. Jackson, do you
21 know if the Applicant will be present on that
22 day?

23 MR. JACKSON: Yes, I can get the
24 Applicant to be present.

25 MS. FLETCHER: If you send me his

1 contact information, his email address, I can
2 send him -- I will send him an invitation.

3 MR. JACKSON: Okay.

4 MS. VIKAN: And Ms. Fletcher, this is
5 Ms. -- this is Nicole Vikan again.

6 If any of the other folks who signed
7 on for the protest with me from the neighborhood
8 wish to attend, are they -- is it possible?

9 Or is it only me who's allowed to
10 attend?

11 MS. FLETCHER: They may attend.

12 MS. VIKAN: Okay.

13 MS. FLETCHER: They are protestants.
14 Normally the designated representative appears.
15 But they are protestants and they're welcome to
16 attend.

17 MS. VIKAN: All right. Thank you for
18 clarifying that.

19 MS. FLETCHER: And it's going to be
20 done via WebEx, just like today. I'm going to
21 send you an invitation.

22 And so I'll see you on November 16.

23 MR. MURPHY: Okay.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

25 MS. VIKAN: Thank you.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Well, anything --
2 anything else?

3 (No response)

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you
5 for participating. I'm going to sign out. Have
6 a great day.

7 Ms. Cruse, were you going to say
8 something?

9 MS. CRUSE: No. No, except that I'm
10 going to see you on Thursday, so.

11 (Laughter)

12 MS. FLETCHER: That's right.

13 MS. CRUSE: We're going to be
14 mediating all the time.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, we are.

16 (Laughter)

17 MS. FLETCHER: And it's a pleasure.
18 Always a pleasure.

19 Well then, I'm going to sign out then.
20 And I'll see everybody soon.

21 MS. CRUSE: Thank you very much.

22 MS. VIKAN: Stay well.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. All right.

24 MS. VIKAN: Thank you.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Bye, bye.

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MR. MURPHY: Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: Take care. All right.

Bye, bye.
