MS. FLETCHER: Okay. I'm going to go ahead and get started. And thank you, everyone for participating in average roll call hearings via online WebEx provided for by the D.C. Office of Open Government.

There -- this is the only roll call haring today. So, I'm just going to call the case.

And then next, I will elevate you, so that you have the option to turn on your cameras and your microphones.

So, I'm going to take a roll call just so that I can know for sure who is present. Oh, and I should remind everyone to mute your computer if you're not speaking.

To mute your computer if you're not speaking, so that the Court Reporter can hear, and we can also hear each other.

And I wanted to remind you to announce yourself whenever you speak. So that the Court Reporter knows who's speaking.

I'm going to do a roll call so that $I$ can be sure that I know who's present. Jackie

Coombe? Ms. Coombe?
MS. COOMBE: Yes. Present. Good morning.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Jeff Jackson?

MR. JACKSON: Present.
MS. FLETCHER: All right. Judith
Bunnell?
MS. BUNNELL: Present also.
MS. FLETCHER: I know that Cookie
Cruse is present.
MS. CRUSE: Present.
MS. FLETCHER: Nicole Vikan?
MS. VIKAN: Good morning. I'm present.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Vikan, good morning. Mr. Murphy?

MR. MURPHY: Hi there Laverne.
MS. FLETCHER: Hey Rick. Thank you. Stephen Lintner?

MR. LINTNER: Yes, I am present. Good morning.

MS. FLETCHER: You are present. Thank you, good morning. Did I miss anybody?

MS. RUTLEDGE: You missed me, Susan

Rutledge.
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay, thank you, Ms. Rutledge. I know you're here. Thank you.

MR. LINTNER: You've also missed another person, Tarleton Watkins.

MR. WATKINS: Yeah, I spoke up earlier about the echo. But, hello. I'm Tarleton, and I'm also present.

MS. FLETCHER: Hi. I have you. Thank you very much.

MR. WATKINS: Thank you. Thank you, Ms. Fletcher.

MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome. Anybody else?
(No response)
MS. FLETCHER: I'm trying to make sure I didn't miss anybody. I think $I$ have everybody.

Okay. Well then, we'll get started. We have several protestants in this case.

We have the Citizens Association of Georgetown. They also have standing as a protestant.

ANC 2E has standing as a protestant. And then there's a group of 12 represented by you, Ms. Vikan? Ms. Vikan?

MS. VIKAN: I guess $I$ can't be heard. Yes, ma'am. Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, I hear you -- I hear you now. You're representing a group of -you're representing a group of 12.

MS. VIKAN: Um-hum.
MS. FLETCHER: And there are several
individuals from your group present today.
MS. VIKAN: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So what I --
MS. VIKAN: We have to have at least five, right?

MS. FLETCHER: That's a - that's fine. Yes, at least five will be good.

MS. VIKAN: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Let me -- let me do this before we go any further. For the Court Reporter, I'm going to want you to state your names and spell them for the record.

Ms. Cruse, you're representing the Citizens Association of Georgetown?

MS. CRUSE: Yes, I am.
MS. FLETCHER: Can you state your name and spell it for the record, please?

MS. CRUSE: Yes. Karen K-A-R-E-N

Cruse C-R-U-S-E.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Mr. Murphy, you're representing ANC 2E?

MR. MURPHY: That is correct. It's Rick --
(Simultaneous speaking)
MS. FLETCHER: Could you please spell

MR. MURPHY: Rick R-I-C-K Murphy M-U-R-P-H-Y. I represent single member district $2 E$ 03.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And is it Ms. Vikan? Am I pronouncing that correctly? MS. VIKAN: Yep. Exactly right, correctly the first time.

MS. FLETCHER: Could you spell your name -- state your name and spell it for the record, please?

MS. VIKAN: Yes, ma'am. It's Nicole Vikan, N-I-C-O-L-E, last name, Vikan, V- as in Victor, I-K-A-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And now if each of the individuals present from your group would state their names and spell it for the record.

Let's start with, Ms. Coombe, you're with the group of 12 , yes?

MS. COOMBE: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Could you --
(Simultaneous speaking)
MS. COOMBE: Jackie J-A-C-K-I-E, last name is Coombe, $C$ - as in Charlie 0-0-M- as in Mary, B- as in boy, E- as in Edward.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And --

MS. COOMBE: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Judith -- Ms. Bunnell, you're part of the group of $12 ?$

MS. BUNNELL: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Could you state your name and spell it please?

MS. BUNNELL: It's Judith Bunnell, J-U-D-I-T-H B- as in Boston U-N-N-E-L-L.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Mr. Lintner, would you state your name and spell it for the record, please?

MR. LINTNER: Stephen Lintner S-T-E-P-H-E-N L-I-N-T-N-E-R, Stephen Lintner.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Ms. Rutledge, if you could do the same?

MS. RUTLEDGE: Yes. It's Susan Rutledge, S-U-S-A-N last name Rutledge R- like Robert, U-T- like Tom, L-E-D-G-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr.
Watkins?
MR. WATKINS: Yes. It's Tarleton
Watkins, T- as in tango A-R-L-E-T-O-N, last name Watkins W-A-T-K-I-N-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very much. Did I le -- did I miss anybody?
(No response)
MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Jackson? Would you state your name and spell it for the record, please?

MR. JACKSON: Yes. Jeff Jackson J-E-F-F J-A-C-K-S-O-N.

MS. FLETCHER: There are at least five individuals present from the group of 12 . And so the group of 12 is grated full standing as a protestant.

So we have three protestants, the Citizens Association of Georgetown, ANC 2E, and a group of 12.

We need to set a date for a mediation. I'll give you the next available day. The next
available day is Thursday, November 19.
Yeah, pretty much any time up until
2:00 a.m. 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 12:00, 1:00. Is -

- we can start with 10:00.

MS. VIKAN: Ms. Fletcher?
MS. FLETCHER: Yes?
MS. VIKAN: Does every --
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, who's speaking?
(Simultaneous speaking)
MS. VIKAN: Oh, I'm sorry.
MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry.
MS. VIKAN: This is Nicole Vikan.
MS. FLETCHER: Hi.
MS. VIKAN: Hi. Since I'm new at the process, who needs to be there? Do I -- am I the only one? Or do all, at least five of us need to be there?

MS. FLETCHER: Only you, the designated representative.

MS. VIKAN: Oh.
MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh.
MS. VIKAN: I'll take as early as possible on the 19th if that works for whomever else is involved. Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, then on
the 19th we can do it at 9:00 or 10:00?
MS. VIKAN: 9:00 works for me.
MR. MURPHY: Ms. Fletcher, the time -this is Rick Murphy.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes?
MR. MURPHY: I think I am going to be on an Interstate on the 19th. Which would make it difficult for me to attend.

Would it be possible for there to be a date the next week that would work?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes. The following week would be, we could make it Monday, November 23.

MR. MURPHY: That would --
(Simultaneous speaking)
MS. FLETCHER: And --
MR. MURPHY: That would work for me.
MS. FLETCHER: That would work?
MR. JACKSON: I'll be on travel.
That's during the Thanksgiving holiday.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well then so, Mr. Jackson, you're going to be away that entire week?

MR. JACKSON: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. In that case let
me see if we can do something earlier the week before. Just a second.

We can do Wednesday, November 18.
(Simultaneous speaking)
MR. MURPHY: Yeah. I believe --
MS. VIKAN: I -- I'm sorry.
MR. MURPHY: I believe I could do that, Ms. Fletcher.

MR. JACKSON: Yeah. That works for me too.

MS. VIKAN: I'm so sorry. But I have child care issues on Wednesdays.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MS. VIKAN: Mondays and Thursdays are ideal for me.

MS. FLETCHER: Mondays and Thursdays?
MS. VIKAN: Yes. If Wednesday needs to happen, I can try to see what I could do. But I can't say right off the bat that it would work.

MS. FLETCHER: Well, what about Monday, the 16th?

MR. JACKSON: That would work.
MS. VIKAN: That's fine with me. I can't speak for others of course.

MR. JACKSON: Yeah That works for me
also.
MS. FLETCHER: 11:00? It would need to be at 11:00 on Monday.

MS. VIKAN: That's fine for me.
MR. JACKSON: Yeah. That's fine for me.

MR. MURPHY: Yeah. I think that will work for me.

MS. VIKAN: Monday the 16th, at 11:00.
MS. FLETCHER: Is that okay for you, Ms. Cruse?

MS. CRUSE: Yes, it is.
MS. FLETCHER: So, Ms. Vikan is good. Mr. Murphy is good. Ms. Cruse is good. Okay. That's everyone.

So, we'll set it for Monday, November 11.

MR. MURPHY: You mean 11:00 -- Monday, November 16, correct?

MS. FLETCHER: Monday, November 16.
I'm sorry, Monday, November 16 at 11:00.
So, I don't have dates for the status and the protest hearings today. By the 16th if I have those dates, I'll provide them to you.

So, we'll just go ahead and proceed
with the -- with the mediation.
Any questions at all from anyone?
MS. VIKAN: Who is at the mediation, Ms. Fletcher?

MS. FLETCHER: Is that Ms. Vikan speaking?

MS. VIKAN: Oh, yes. I'm sorry.
MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. You will
be there. Rick Murphy will be there from ANC 2 E . And Karen Cruse will be there from the Citizens Association of Georgetown, and me, I'm the Board's mediator.

So, just the four of us.
MS. VIKAN: No one from the other -from the folks representing the --

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, I'm sorry. Jeff Jackson. Jeff Jackson is representing the establishment.

MS. VIKAN: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: So, Mr. Jackson, do you know if the Applicant will be present on that day?

MR. JACKSON: Yes, $I$ can get the Applicant to be present.

MS. FLETCHER: If you send me his
contact information, his email address, I can send him -- I will send him an invitation.

MR. JACKSON: Okay.
MS. VIKAN: And Ms. Fletcher, this is Ms. -- this is Nicole Vikan again.

If any of the other folks who signed on for the protest with me from the neighborhood wish to attend, are they -- is it possible?

Or is it only me who's allowed to
attend?
MS. FLETCHER: They may attend.
MS. VIKAN: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: They are protestants. Normally the designated representative appears. But they are protestants and they're welcome to attend.

MS. VIKAN: All right. Thank you for clarifying that.

MS. FLETCHER: And it's going to be done via WebEx, just like today. I'm going to send you an invitation.

And so I'll see you on November 16.
MR. MURPHY: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MS. VIKAN: Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: Well, anything -anything else?
(No response)
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you for participating. I'm going to sign out. Have a great day.

Ms. Cruse, were you going to say something?

MS. CRUSE: No. No, except that I'm going to see you on Thursday, so.
(Laughter)
MS. FLETCHER: That's right.
MS. CRUSE: We're going to be mediating all the time.

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, we are.
(Laughter)
MS. FLETCHER: And it's a pleasure.
Always a pleasure.
Well then, I'm going to sign out then.
And I'll see everybody soon.
MS. CRUSE: Thank you very much.
MS. VIKAN: Stay well.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. All right.
MS. VIKAN: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Bye, bye.

MR. MURPHY: Thank you.
