3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4 on our Show Cause Hearing (Status) is Case No.
5 19-CMP-00005, Los Cuates Restaurant, License No.
6 79261.

7 Would the parties, please, approach
8 and identify themselves for the record, please?

9 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
10 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
11 Columbia.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Rivero.

13 MS. YOHANNES: Good morning. Sidon
14 Yohannes on behalf of the licensee.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
16 Ms. Yohannes.

17 Are there any preliminary matters in
18 this case?

19 MR. RIVERO: Yes, there are. The
20 parties have an Offer in Compromise to present to
21 the Board, at this time. And that offer consists
22 of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 30 days. If the

1 fine is not paid in that time, the license will
2 be suspended until payment is received. That is
3 the offer.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes,
5 it's my understanding that there is an Offer in
6 Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise is that
7 there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 30 days. If
8 the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license
9 will be suspended. Is this your understanding of
10 the Offer in Compromise?

11 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your
13 client aware that by accepting an Offer in
14 Compromise, that they are giving up their right
15 to a hearing?

16 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client
18 also aware that by accepting an Offer in
19 Compromise, that they are giving up their right
20 to appeal this matter?

21 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,

1 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise
2 of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 30 days be
3 accepted. If the fine is not payable in 30 days,
4 the license will be suspended until the fine has
5 been paid. Is there a second?

6 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
8 has seconded the motion.

9 All those in favor say aye.

10 ALL: Aye.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The matter
12 passes 5-0-0. All right.

13 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

15 Hearing was concluded at 9:47 a.m.)
