3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Now for our
4 afternoon show-cause hearing, our first case is
5 Case Number 19-CIT-00588, MLK Mini Market,
6 License Number 113398. Will the parties please
7 approach and identify themselves for the record,
8 please.

9 MR. LUI: Good afternoon. John Lui,
10 on behalf of the Government.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon,
12 Mr. Lui.

13 MR. HUSEN: Hi. Good afternoon. Abdu
14 Husen.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I can't hear
16 you, sir.

17 MR. HUSEN: Abdu Husen.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Husen?

19 MR. HUSEN: Husen.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon,
21 Mr. Husen. There's a sign-in sheet. Could you
22 please sign your name in on the sheet, please.
23 All right. Are there any preliminary matters in
24 this case?

25 MR. LUI: Yes.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what's
2 that?

3 MR. LUI: There is an offer in
4 compromise to present to the Board.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What's that?

6 MR. LUI: The offer in compromise for
7 the one charge of no ABC manager is a \$300 fine,
8 made payable within 30 days or its license shall
9 be suspended indefinitely until this fine is
10 paid.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Husen, it's
12 my understanding that there is an offer in
13 compromise and the offer in compromise is that
14 there is a fine of \$300, payable in 30 days. If
15 the fine is not paid within 30 days, the license
16 will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

17 Is this your understanding of the
18 offer in compromise?

19 MR. HUSEN: Yes, sir.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
21 that by accepting an offer in compromise that
22 you're giving up your right to a hearing?

23 MR. HUSEN: Yes.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
25 aware that by accepting an offer in compromise

1 that you're giving up your right to appeal this
2 matter?

3 MR. HUSEN: Yes.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
5 With that said, I make a motion that the offer in
6 compromise of a fine of \$300, payable within 30
7 days, be accepted. If the fine is not paid
8 within 30 days, the license will be suspended
9 until the fine has been paid. Is there a second?

10 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

11 MEMBER CATO: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short and
13 Mr. Cato second the motion. All those in favor,
14 say aye.

15 (Chorus of ayes)

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed.
17 The matter passes 4-0-0. Thank the parties for
18 working this matter out, sign-off on the
19 paperwork, and have a great day. Thank you.

21 entitled matter was concluded at 1:47 p.m.)
