19	MR. HUSEN: Yes, sir.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
21	that by accepting an offer in compromise that
22	you're giving up your right to a hearing?
23	MR. HUSEN: Yes.
24	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
25	aware that by accepting an offer in compromise

1 that you're giving up your right to appeal this 2 matter? 3 MR. If the fine is not paid 8 within 30 days, the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.
