**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND
REINSTATING LICENSE**

On September 20, 2023, the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer’s Class CR License No. ABRA-122495 held by Mariachi Lounge Bar & Grill, LLC, t/a Mariachi Lounge (Petitioner), because the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration’s (ABCA) Enforcement Division determined that the Petitioner was out of business. *See* Board Order No. 2023-472.

On August 30, 2023, the ABCA’s Licensing Division provided a written notice to the Licensee. The notice advised the Licensee that if its establishment was no longer operational, the license must be surrendered to the Board for safekeeping or the license would be cancelled pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791.

On October 10, 2023, the Petitioner sought reinstatement of the Retailer’s Class CR License No. ABRA-122495. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that the establishment was not out of business, it was a miscommunication with ABCA.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 18th day of October 2023, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on September 20, 2023, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-122495 be **REINSTATED**.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
