ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On September 20, 2023, the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-122495 held by Mariachi Lounge Bar & Grill, LLC, t/a Mariachi Lounge (Petitioner), because the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration's (ABCA) Enforcement Division determined that the Petitioner was out of business. *See* Board Order No. 2023-472.

On August 30, 2023, the ABCA's Licensing Division provided a written notice to the Licensee. The notice advised the Licensee that if its establishment was no longer operational, the license must be surrendered to the Board for safekeeping or the license would be cancelled pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791.

On October 10, 2023, the Petitioner sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-122495. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that the establishment was not out of business, it was a miscommunication with ABCA.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 18th day of October 2023, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on September 20, 2023, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-122495 be REINSTATED.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
