
ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST

On April 29, 2020, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2020-199 ordering 2400 Minnesota Avenue, SE, LLC, t/a Martha's Market (Respondent), holder of a Retailer's Class B License No. ABRA-105036, to stop selling alcoholic beverages at the Respondent's establishment. Based upon an investigation, it was determined that the Respondent transferred its license to new owner without the approval of the Board.

On May 28, 2020, the Board approved a Temporary Operator's Retail Permit authorizing the purchaser to operate under the Transferor's Retailer's Class B License No. ABRA-105036 until the Transfer Application is approved and the new license is issued. *See* Board Order No. 2020-210.

Accordingly, it is this 28th day of May, 2020, **ORDERED**, that the **ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST** issued against 2400 Minnesota Avenue, SE, LLC, t/a Martha's Market, by the Board on April 29, 2020, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), be and hereby is **VACATED**.

Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E StTeet, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
