3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4	on our calendar is Case number 17-CC-00117, Mason
5	Inn, License number 104588. Will the parties
6	please approach and identify themselves for the
7	record, please?
8	MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
9	Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
10	Columbia, standing in for Assistant Attorney
11	General Gephardt.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
13	again, Mr. Rivero.
14	MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Good morning.
15	I'm Richard Ibarguengoitia, the owner of Mason
16	Inn. I apologize. I appreciate your desire to
17	be formal. But please just call me Richard.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Now, give me
19	your name one more time. I was looking around at
20	our own back. And I said that if, I know I have
21	problems with names. And I asked Mr.
22	Silverstein, who always says that he knows how to

pronounce names to pronounce it for me. And he 1 2 was having -- So, one more time for me, please, sir. 3 4 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: It's 5 Ibarguengoitia. Ibarguengoitia. 6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 7 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Good. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 9 Thank you. 10 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Thank you. MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Mr. Chairman --11 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Don't ask me to 13 do it one more time. Yes, Mr. Silverstein. 14 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I told you so. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And, yes, Mr. 16 Silverstein was correct when he tried to assist 17 me in the pronunciation of your name, sir. 18 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Nice work. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, I 20 appreciate that. But just for that I need you to 21 sign in on the record there. 22 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Of course, sir.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, at least
2	for the transcript it will be spelled correctly.
3	Thank you.
4	MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Not a problem.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
6	(Off the record comments)
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Rivero, are
8	there any preliminary matters in this case?
9	MR. RIVERO: Yes. The parties have an
10	offer in compromise to present to the Board at
11	this time. The offer is as follows. First, I
12	note that the license is currently in
13	safekeeping.
14	The offer in compromise is a fine of
15	\$3,000 dollars payable within 60 days. And then,
16	upon removal of the license from safekeeping the
17	following terms.
18	A suspension of the license for five
19	days. All five days stayed for a period of one
20	year, pending no further violations. And the
21	provision of training for employees who serve
22	alcoholic beverages. That training to take place
-	

within 90 days.

If the fine is not paid, well, this is still in safekeeping. So that normally the fine, the license would be suspended until the payment is received. But please note that the, functionally it's the same. The license would not be able to

7 it's the same. The license would not be able to
8 be withdrawn from safekeeping until the fine is
9 paid, if it's not paid within 60 days. That is
10 the offer in compromise.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr. 12 Richard, so I'm now, I'll stay while I'm ahead. 13 It's my understanding that there's an offer in 14 compromise. And the offer in compromise is that 15 there is a fine of \$3,000 dollars. And the fine 16 of \$3,000 dollars will be payable within 60 days.

17 If the fine is not payable within 60 18 days the license will remain in safekeeping, and 19 cannot be removed from safekeeping until the fine 20 has been paid. That's my understanding, that the 21 license is currently in safekeeping.

Also, along with this fine, once the

Neal R. Gross and Co., Inc. Washington DC license is removed from safekeeping there is a
 five day suspension. And all five days are
 stayed for one year.

And along with this charge is that 4 5 within 90 days of the removal of the license from safekeeping all employees will undergo training, 6 7 alcohol training, the employees who serve alcohol 8 will undergo training. Is this your 9 understanding, sir, of the offer in compromise? 10 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Yes, sir. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 12 that by accepting an offer in compromise that you 13 are giving up your right to a hearing? 14 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Yes. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And are you 16 also aware that by accepting an offer in 17 compromise that you have given up your right to 18 appeal this matter? 19 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Yes. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With this said 21 I then make a motion that the offer in compromise of a fine of \$3,000 dollars, payable in 60 days. 22

If the fine is not payable in 60 days the license 1 2 will, the license which is currently in safekeeping will remain in safekeeping. 3 And the license cannot be removed from safekeeping until 4 5 the fine has been paid. Secondly that within, once the license 6 7 has been removed from safekeeping the license 8 will be suspended for five days. And all five 9 days are stayed for one year. Thirdly, that within 90 days after the 10 removal of the license from safekeeping all 11 12 employees who serve alcohol will undergo 13 training. Is there a second? 14 MEMBER SHORT: Second. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has seconded the motion. All those in favor say aye. 16 17 (Chorus of aye.) 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed? 19 (No response) 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The matter 21 passed 6-0-0. The Board will issue a Board Order on this matter, meaning that we'll issue the 22

1 Board Order, and the 90 days will start the 2 effective date of the Board Order. Okay? Thank 3 you, sir. Sixty days, actually. 4 MR. RIVERO: 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. I'm 6 sorry, within 60 days. Sixty days after the 7 issuance of the Board Order. All right. Thank 8 you. 9 MR. IBARGUENGOITIA: Yes, sir. Thank you for your time. And enjoy your vacation. 10 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, the Board 12 is going on a recess. It's, we come back after 13 Labor Day. So it's, we'll see how much we enjoy 14 our recess. But thank you. Thank you, sir. 15 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter 16 went off the record at 10:28 a.m.) 17 18 19 20 21 22
