## ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF APPLICATION

The Application filed by Kaza Lounge, LLC, t/a Medusa Lounge (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 31, 2023, and a Protest Status Hearing on September 13, 2023.

On September 13, 2023, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order 2023-469.

On September 19, 2023, Dawit Sermolo, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Mr. Sermolo seeks reinstatement of the Application so the Applicant and ANC 1E can continue working towards a final Settlement Agreement. ANC 1E did not object to the Applicant's request for reinstatement.

Upon consideration of this uncontested request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

## ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 20th day of September 2023, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Kaza Lounge, LLC, t/a Medusa Lounge, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
