10	MR. DIETZ: Pardon?
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're going to
12	issue a Board Order in the first case.
13	MR. DIETZ: Yes.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
15	Would the parties please identify
16	themselves for the record, please?
17	MR. LUI: Good morning, Mr.
18	Chairperson. John Lui, on behalf of the
19	Government.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
21	Mr. Lui.
22	MS. YOHANNES: Good morning, Sidon
23	Yohannes, on behalf of the Licensee.
24	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes.
25	This matter was actually a show cause hearing.

1	Are there any preliminary matters in this case?				
2	MR. LUI: Yes, Mr. Chairperson.				
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is				
4	that, please?				
5	MR. LUI: There is an offer in				
6	compromise to present to the Board.				
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is				
8	that?				
9	MR. LUI: For Charge 1, sale to a				
10	minor, the offer in compromise is a warning.				
11	And for Charge 2, no ABC manager,				
12	the offer in compromise is a \$1,250 fine, made				
13	payable within 30 days or its license shall be				
14	suspended indefinitely until this fine is paid.				
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.				
16	Ms. Yohannes, it's my understanding that there				
17	is an offer in compromise in this case.				
18	And the offer in compromise is for				
19	Charge 1, there is a warning and for Charge 2,				
20	that there is a fine of \$1,250, payable within				
21	30 days.				
22	If the fine is not paid within 30				
23	days, the license will be suspended until the				
24	fine has been paid.				
25	Is this you and your client's				

understanding of the offer in compromise? 1 2 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your 3 4 client aware that by accepting an offer in 5 compromise that they are giving up their right to a hearing? 6 7 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your 9 client also aware that by accepting an offer in 10 compromise that they're giving up their right to 11 appeal this matter? 12 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 14 With that said, I make a motion that the offer 15 in compromise of, for Charge 1, there is a written warning issued. 16 17 For Charge 2, there is a fine of 18 \$1,250, payable within 30 days. If the fine is 19 not paid within 30 days, the license will be 20 suspended until the fine has been paid. 21 Is there a second? 22 MEMBER CATO: Second. 23 MEMBER CROCKETT: Second. 24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato and 25 Ms. Crockett have seconded the motion. All
