ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION AND ANC 1E'S PROTEST

The Application filed by Kaza Lounge, LLC, t/a Medusa Lounge (Applicant), for a renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on April 24, 2023.

On April 24, 2023, the Board dismissed the Application and the Protest of ANC 1E. Specifically, the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing and the ANC 1E's protest letter did not indicate that the ANC's vote was held at a duly noticed public hearing.

The Applicant and ANC 1E may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
