The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of Mirror Lounge please come forward? This is Case Number 20-PRO-00003, 9th Street Lounge, LLC, 1920 9th Street NW, License \#ABRA-111950.

This is a Retailer Class CT, substantial change from a garden with 13 seats. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and real property values.

My name is Laverne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Introductions beginning with the Applicant, please?

MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on behalf of the Applicant. And that's S-I-D-O-N, Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, and present on behalf of the protestants?

MR. SCHLOM: We have 3 members of a group of 11 here today. First, Evan Schlom, E-V-A-N, S-C-H-L-O-M.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Schlom. MS. NORMAN: Anita Norman, A-N-I-T-A, N-O-R-M-A-N.

MR. ESPINOSA: And Luis Espinosa, L-U-I-S, and my last name Espinosa is E-S-P-I-N-O-SA.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. The group of 11 is granted conditional standing.

Three members of the group are present today, that means that at least two individuals not present today would need to show up for the upcoming status hearing, at which time the Board would grant board standing.

We'll just move through the proceedings, I'll give you the next dates. The next dates, the status hearing, which is scheduled for March 25, 2020 at 9:30 a.m., is the status hearing.

The protest hearing is scheduled for April 22nd at 4:30 p.m. I will give you the next available date for mediation.

MS. YOHANNES: Ms. Fletcher?
MS. FLETCHER: Yes?
MS. YOHANNES: Before you give the mediation date, just for the record, there are
actually only two members of the group of five or more here.

So, they need to actually appear for the next --

MS. FLETCHER: So, there's someone who didn't sign the protest letter?

MS. YOHANNES: I'm sorry?
MS. FLETCHER: There's someone here who didn't sign the protest letter?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes. Ms. Norman.
Commissioner Norman is here.
MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Norman.
MR. SCHLOM: You have the protest?
You have a copy of it?
MS. YOHANNES: I do.
MS. FLETCHER: Let me look again.
MS. YOHANNES: I have my copy.
MR. SCHLOM: I'm not going to keep it.
MS. FLETCHER: Let me look at mine and make sure we all have all the pages. On my pages I don't see Ms. Norman but, Ms. Norman, it's nice to see you anyway.

So, we actually have two individuals from the group present, which means that at least three need to appear that aren't present today.

I gave you the date for the status hearing, which is March 25th at 9:30 a.m. The protest hearing is April 22nd at 4:30 p.m.

I'll give you the next available date for mediation now. The next available date for mediation is February 17th at 1:00 p.m. otherwise we will move to March.

MR. SCHLOM: That's a holiday.
MS. FLETCHER: That's a holiday?
MR. SCHLOM: It's President's Day.
MS. FLETCHER: I think I had the wrong calendar. Let me make a note of that. So then we'll move to the month of March. President's Day.

How about Tuesday, March 3rd? Any time between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.?

MR. SCHLOM: I'd like to do earlier. How about 9:00 a.m.? Does that work for you?

MS. YOHANNES: That day actually does not work. Any time after the 9 th of March.

MS. FLETCHER: After the 9th? We can do March 17th at 9:00 a.m. You said not the week of the 9th, right, Ms. Yohannes?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes. I can do the week of the 9 th as well, $I$ can do the 17 th as well. I
just meant not the rest of that week.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so you couldn't do the 3rd, right?

MS. YOHANNES: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: What about March 10th at 9:00 a.m.?

MR. SCHLOM: That's fine for us. MS. FLETCHER: Is that fine for you too, Ms. Yohannes?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes, that's fine. MR. SCHLOM: March 10th, 9:00 a.m.? MS. FLETCHER: March 10th, 9:00 a.m., yes. Mediation is set for march 10th at 9:00 a.m. Any questions? Okay, well, the roll call hearing is concluded and thank you for coming. (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter went off the record at 10:35 a.m.)
