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**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

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The application filed by Miss Toya’s Southern Cajun Kitchen, t/a Miss Toya’s Southern Cajun Kitchen (Applicant), for a New Retailer’s Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on January 18, 2022, at 10:00 am.

On the day of the hearing, the Board dismissed the Applicant for failing to appear at the Roll Call Hearing, which is described in Board Order No. 2022-019. The Applicant in its motion for reinstatement and reconsideration states that the Applicant received incorrect information and did not receive proper notice without further explanation. Nevertheless, the Board’s records show that the correct date and time of the hearing was posted on the placard and ABRA sent the appropriate notice with the correct date and time

that instructed the Applicant that the hearing would occur. Finally, the request for reconsideration was not timely filed.

### **ORDER**

Therefore, the Board, on this 9th day of February 2022, hereby **DENIES** the motion for reconsideration. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Parties.

Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
