**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND
REINSTATING LICENSE**

On August 18, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class CR License No. ABRA-074714 held by Jun & Jin, Inc., t/a Momoyama (Petitioner), because the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration's (ABRA) Enforcement Division determined that the Petitioner was out of business. *See* Board Order No. 2021-474.

On July 19, 2021, the ABRA's Licensing Division provided a written notice to the Petitioner. The notice advised the Petitioner that if its establishment was no longer operational, the license must be surrendered to the Board for safekeeping or the license would be cancelled pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791. There was not initial response to the notice.

However, on March 29, 2022, Mr. Rim, on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-074714. In support of his request for

reinstatement, Mr. Rim indicated that he did not receive the written notice mailed by the Licensing Division and that his business was temporarily closed due to his health.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 30th day of March 2022, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on August 18, 2021, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-074714 be **REINSTATED**.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
