CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The second case on our Show Cause Hearing (Status) calendar is Case No. 17-CIT-00020, 100 Montaditos, License No. 94846.

Will the parties, please, approach and identify themselves for the record?

MR. CHATTRABHUTI: Good morning, Members of the Board. Pete Chattrabhuti on behalf of the District of Columbia.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr. Chattrabhuti. Sir, have a seat and, please, identify yourself for the record.

MR. WALKER: My name is Steve Walker.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr. Walker. And who are you, sir?

MR. WALKER: And I am representing the 100 Montaditos Restaurant.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: When you say you are representing, what do you mean you are representing? You are the what?

1 MR. WALKER: I am the -- I am in
2 charge of operations at the store.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Now, do you
4 have a letter stating that you are authorized to
5 represent the store?

6 MR. WALKER: I don't have an official
7 letter with me. I do not.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you able to
9 provide the Agency with an additional -- with a
10 letter by close of business today?

11 MR. WALKER: Absolutely.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Let me ask --

13 MR. WALKER: Absolutely.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- a question.
15 Is there a preliminary matter in this case?

16 MR. CHATTRABHUTI: Yes. The parties
17 have an OIC to present to the Board.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Are
19 you able, sir, to provide this Agency with a
20 letter on its letterhead authorizing you to enter
21 into an agreement binding this today?

22 MR. WALKER: Yes, sir, definitely.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. So all
2 right, Ms. Randall, can you --

3 MS. RANDALL: We have a card.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We will give
5 you the card, so you need to -- I will ask that
6 by close of business -- you can do it today.

7 MR. WALKER: Okay.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So by close of
9 business today you need to provide the Agency
10 with this authorization.

11 MR. WALKER: Okay.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr.
13 Chattrabhuti, are there any preliminary matters
14 in this case?

15 MR. CHATTRABHUTI: Yes, Mr. Chairman.
16 There is an OIC that the parties would like to
17 present to the Board this morning.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is the
19 OIC, sir?

20 MR. CHATTRABHUTI: For Charge 1, no
21 ABC Manager or owner on premises. There will be
22 a fine of \$600 payable within 30 days or the

1 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
2 fine is paid.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Walker,
4 it's my understanding that there is an Offer in
5 Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise is that
6 there is a fine of \$600 payable in 30 days. If
7 it is not payable in 30 days, the license will be
8 suspended.

9 Is this your understanding, sir, of
10 the Offer in Compromise?

11 MR. WALKER: Yes, it is.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
13 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
14 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

15 MR. WALKER: Yes.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And that you
17 are also aware that by accepting an Offer in
18 Compromise, that you are giving up your right to
19 appeal this matter?

20 MR. WALKER: Correct, yes.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

22 With that said, I then make a motion that the

1 Offer in Compromise of a fine of \$600 payable in
2 30 days, if the fine is not payable in 30 days,
3 the matter is -- the license will be suspended
4 until compliance has been made. Is there a
5 second?

6 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
8 seconded the motion.

9 All those in favor say aye.

10 ALL: Aye.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
12 The matter passes 6-0-0.

13 So we will have you sign, sir, this to
14 agree to the Offer in Compromise. However, I do
15 ask you that you need to provide this
16 authorization to the Board by close of business
17 today.

18 MR. WALKER: Correct.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. All
20 right.

21 All right. So she will have you sign-
22 off on the paperwork.

1 MR. WALKER: All right.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

3 Thank you.

4 MR. WALKER: Thank you.

5 (Whereupon, the Show Cause (Status)

6 Hearing was concluded at 10:00 a.m.)
