3 AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in  
4 the matter of La Goulu, Inc. t/a Montmartre/7th  
5 Hill, please, come forward? This is Case No. 19-  
6 PRO-00020. 327 7th Street, S.E., License No.  
7 ABRA-060422, Retailer Class CR License renewal.

8 The protest issues are adverse impact  
9 on peace, order and quiet.

10 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting  
11 the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent.

12 Introductions beginning with the  
13 applicant, please. Good morning. If you could  
14 state your name and spell it for the record?

15 MR. RAYNAL: Sure. Christopher  
16 Raynal, C-H-R-I-S-T-O-P-H-E-R Raynal, it's R-A-  
17 Y-N-A-L.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.  
19 Raynal. Mr. Raynal, did you put your contact  
20 information on that sheet already?

21 MR. RAYNAL: Yes, ma'am.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very

1 much.

2 Present on behalf of ANC-6B?

3 MR. JAYARAMAN: For ANC-6B, this is  
4 Chander Jayaraman, C-H-A-N-D-E-R last name  
5 spelled J-A-Y-A-R-A-M-A-N. I'm the chairman of  
6 the ABC Committee for ANC-6B.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.  
8 Jayaraman.

9 ANC-6B has standing as a protestant.  
10 We need to set a date for mediation, a Status  
11 Hearing and a Protest Hearing. I'll give you the  
12 date for the Status and Protest Hearing first.

13 The day of the Status Hearing is June  
14 5. June 5, 2019 at 9:30 for the Status Hearing.

15 The Protest Hearing is set for July  
16 10, July 10 at 1:30 p.m.

17 We need to set a date for mediation.  
18 I'll give you the next available dates. The next  
19 available day for mediation is Tuesday, May 14 at  
20 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 11:30, 1:00?

21 MR. JAYARAMAN: Ms. Fletcher, could we  
22 look at the following week or the last week of

1 the month, please?

2 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Let's see here,  
3 what about, just a second, is the 21st better? We  
4 can move to the following week.

5 MR. JAYARAMAN: The following week,  
6 please.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: The following week.  
8 Okay. Then let's do -- what about Thursday, May  
9 30?

10 MR. JAYARAMAN: Okay.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: Would that work for--  
12 excuse me one second.

13 MR. JAYARAMAN: Ms. Fletcher, just to  
14 be open and transparent --

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Um-hum.

16 MR. JAYARAMAN: -- we fully expect to  
17 have any issues resolved with the applicant by  
18 that point, so I know this is somewhat  
19 administrative in nature, why we are setting this  
20 date, so that we retain our standing.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.

22 MR. JAYARAMAN: But we do fully expect

1 to have everything resolved and do not expect to  
2 go to a full protest with this applicant.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Well, thank you very  
4 much. I made a note of that as well. So we can  
5 just -- I understand we are pushing it out as far  
6 as possible.

7 MR. JAYARAMAN: Right. So that is  
8 fine with us.

9 AGENT FLETCHER: With what you expect  
10 to occur.

11 MR. RAYNAL: Yes, it is.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: So we will just set  
13 it for the 30th at 10:00?

14 MR. JAYARAMAN: Perfect.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Mediation is set for  
16 10:00 on Thursday, May 30.

17 Any questions at all?

18 MR. RAYNAL: No, ma'am.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. As I said, I  
20 made a note that you expect to resolve it before  
21 then, but it's just on the books, on the record.

22 And, Mr. Jayaraman, do you know what

1 to do once you settle it, send it to our office--

2 MR. JAYARAMAN: Yes, ma'am.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: -- you know the  
4 procedure? Okay. Okay. Well, thank you very  
5 much for coming. The Roll Call Hearing is  
6 concluded.

7 MR. JAYARAMAN: Thanks.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.

9 MR. RAYNAL: Thank you.
