ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On May 15, 2019, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2019-360 cancelling Romi-Rome Productions, LLC, t/a Morgan's Seafood Bar & Grill (Petitioner), License No. ABRA-084925.

Specifically, the Petitioner failed to pay the safekeeping fee for its License No. ABRA-084925 despite being notified by ABRA of the payment due date.

On June 10, 2019, Romeo Morgan, on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-084925. In support of his request for reinstatement, Mr. Romeo stated that the Petitioner failed to pay the safekeeping fee due to a miscommunication regarding the safekeeping process and requirements.

The Board finds good cause and that the reinstatement of the license is proper, with the condition that the Petitioner pays the required safekeeping fee.

Accordingly, it is this 12th day of June, 2019, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Romi-Rome Productions, LLC, t/a Morgan's Seafood Bar & Grill, by the Board on May 15, 2019, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-084925 be REINSTATED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner shall pay the required safekeeping fee within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
