3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case  
4 on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-00078,  
5 Mythology & Lore/Dirty Water, License No. 95033.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and  
7 identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips,  
9 Assistant Attorney General, for the District of  
10 Columbia.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I see that the  
12 licensee is not here for this case.

13 This matter is scheduled for a Show  
14 Cause Hearing on June 5th at 3:30 p.m.

15 MS. PHILLIPS: The same attorney has  
16 this case that had the previous case and I  
17 understand June 5th was not good for her, so we  
18 can move this to the 12th like we did the last  
19 case.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: This is a Show  
21 Cause Hearing (Status), right?

22 MS. PHILLIPS: It is.

1                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. Mythology  
2                   & Lore/Dirty Water. When can it be scheduled for  
3                   -- I don't -- we will -- the Agency will get  
4                   back, because that's going to be a Show Cause and  
5                   we already have a Show Cause Hearing on 11 and  
6                   I'm not sure what is on the calendar. So we will  
7                   get back to both yourself and the licensee's  
8                   attorney for the date and time of the Show Cause  
9                   Hearing.

10                   MS. PHILLIPS: Yes, Ms. Schmidt is  
11                   the --

12                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.  
13                   Then what -- June 12th at 4:30.

14                   MS. PHILLIPS: June 12, okay.

15                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: June 12th at  
16                   4:30.

17                   MS. PHILLIPS: At 4:30. All right.  
18                   Thank you, Mr. Chair.

19                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.  
20                   You're welcome.

21                   The Board then will be in recess.

22                   (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter

1 went off the record at 9:42 a.m. and resumed at  
2 11:34 a.m.)

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.  
4 Prior to -- we had a Show Cause Hearing (Status)  
5 for Case No. 18-CMP-00078, Mythology & Lore/Dirty  
6 Water, License No. 95033.

7 The Government was here, but the  
8 representative for the licensee was not here when  
9 this was called at 9:30 this morning.

10 It's my understanding that a  
11 representative of the licensee is here at this  
12 moment and he would like to make a statement for  
13 the record.

14 Please, come forward, sir, and  
15 identify yourself for the record.

16 MR. GRANDIS: Good morning. My name  
17 is Ed Grandis and I'm here embarrassed and want  
18 to make a statement for the record.

19 I had a recurrence of sciatica a  
20 couple days ago and the medication does help me  
21 to get rid of the pain, but also makes me drowsy.  
22 I awoke at 7:30 this morning and I got up and I

1 was a bit dizzy and so I sat back down and fell  
2 back asleep. I woke up probably, I think, 10:50  
3 and I immediately realized that I have been rude  
4 to the Board by not being here in time.

5 But I felt like I wanted to come down  
6 and make a statement for the record that my  
7 client and the Assistant AG, Amy Schmidt, I  
8 believe, we are in consultation. She explained  
9 to me she is out of town until the 13th. I do  
10 believe this is going to be resolved rather  
11 quickly, so that there would not need to be a  
12 Show Cause, but, of course, I cannot make that  
13 representation today, other than to say there is  
14 cooperation on both sides.

15 There is an understanding of trying to  
16 get this resolved. And I just wanted to let the  
17 Board know I respect your authority and I very  
18 much apologize for not being here at 9:30.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you very  
20 much, Mr. Grandis, for your representation. I  
21 appreciate that. I had stated that, and it's --  
22 I think the attorney who filled in this morning

1 was -- she was Amy -- I'm sorry, Louise Phillips  
2 was the attorney of record for the month. So we  
3 had changed the date of the Show Cause Hearing to  
4 June 12th at 4:30.

5 So that's not the date that was on,  
6 but the matter is scheduled for a Show Cause  
7 Hearing on June 12th at 4:30 and if it goes to a  
8 Show Cause Hearing, I will keep it in mind that  
9 you did appear here this morning and you didn't  
10 have a chance to speak to the attorney of record.

11 So I appreciate that. Thank you very  
12 much, sir.

13 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Thank you, sir.

14 MR. GRANDIS: And I want to thank you  
15 all for giving me this time to speak to you all.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The  
17 Board appreciates that.

18 MR. GRANDIS: Have a good day.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you very  
20 much. All right.
