3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of Nando Peri Peri, please come
5 forward? This is case number 19-PRO-00063.
6 Nando's on H Street, LLC, 411 H Street, NE,
7 license number ABRA-097889. This is a Retailer
8 Class CR License renewal.

9 The protest issues are adverse impact
10 on peace, order and quiet, residential parking
11 and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

12 Introduction beginning with the
13 applicant, please. If you could -- the
14 representative from Nando's Peri Peri if you
15 could just state your name and spell it for the
16 record.

17 MS. VAZQUEZ: My name is Marina
18 Vazquez, M-A-R-I-N-A, V, as in Victor, --A-Z, as
19 in zebra --Q-U-E-Z, as in zebra.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Q-U-E --
21 what are the last two letters?

22 MS. VAZQUEZ: Q-U-E -

1 MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh.

2 MS. VAZQUEZ: -- Z, as in zebra.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

4 MS. VAZQUEZ: You're welcome.

5 MS. FLETCHER: And person on behalf of
6 ANC 6C?

7 MR. ECKENWILER: Mark Eckenwiler, M-A-
8 R-K, last name is E-C-K-E-N-W-I-L-E-R, on behalf
9 of ANC 6C.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
11 Eckenwiler. ANC 6C has standing as a Protestant.
12 We need to set a date for a mediation, a Status
13 Hearing and a Protest Hearing. I'll give you the
14 date for the Status and Protest Hearing first.

15 The Status Hearing is set for August
16 14. August 14, 2019, at 9:30 a.m., for the
17 Status Hearing. The Protest Hearing is set for
18 September 25. September 25, at 4:30 p.m. I will
19 give you the next available date for mediation.
20 The next available date for mediation is Tuesday,
21 July 30. Tuesday, July 30 at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00,
22 12:00, 1:00 or in the afternoon, 2:00 or 3:00,

2 MR. ECKENWILER: Just to be clear,
3 that is 3-0?

4 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, 3-0, uh-huh,
5 that's Tuesday, 3-0. That's -

6 MR. ECKENWILER: I think any of those
7 times will do -- prove right -- for me.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Either one of those
9 times will be okay for you, Mr. Eckenwiler?

10 MR. ECKENWILER: Yep.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

12 MR. ECKENWILER: Seems fine.

14 check my calendar -

15 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
