**ORDER MODIFYING BOARD ORDER NO. 2017-433**

---

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, on this 27th day of March 2019, hereby **GRANTS** the petition to modify the conditions imposed by the Board in Board Order No. 2017-433. The modifications are as follows:

1. Conditions (a) and (b) in Board Order No. 2017-433, which are contained in Paragraph 62, shall be struck. This lifts all Board-imposed restrictions on the license holder's hours of sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages and entertainment hours. If the license holder seeks additional hours, it should file an application for a substantial change with the Board and obtain approval for additional hours.
2. The license holder is prohibited from using the third floor, fourth floor, and roof for any purpose related to the business, including use by customers or the storage of inventory, until an appropriate application for a substantial change is filed and approved by the Board.

All other terms and conditions of Board Order No. 2017-433 shall remain in full force and effect.





Under 23 DCMR § 1719.1, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, under section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
