## ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA has reviewed its records and determined that Hirschhorn, LLC, t/a Open Door Market (Respondent), has failed to renew its Retailer's Class B License No. ABRA-109402. Specifically, the Respondent failed to renew its license by September 30, 2023, the deadline for all Retailer's Class B licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date.

On November 1, 2023, the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist 2023-588 against the Respondent, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class B License. The Respondent did not respond to the Order to Cease and Desist.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 15th day of November 2023, that Hirschhorn, LLC's License No. ABRA-109402 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR

§1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
