3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
4 next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-
5 00090, Panda Gourmet, License No. 86961.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and
7 identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MR. SOUSA: Christopher Sousa for the
9 District of Columbia.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
11 Mr. Sousa.

12 MR. JONES: Mark Jones for Panda
13 Gourmet, T & L Hospitality.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
15 Mr. Jones. And, Mr. Jones, what's your
16 relationship to this?

17 MR. JONES: General manager for T & L
18 Hospitality.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, I'm not --
20 have you appeared in front of me before, sir?

21 MR. JONES: I have.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. All

1 right. Your face looks familiar that's one of
2 the reasons I -- I don't have -- your name is not
3 listed here, so -- but I assume you have
4 previously provided authority to the Board.

5 MR. JONES: Yes, I have.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Fine.

7 All right. Mr. Sousa, are there any preliminary
8 matters in this case?

9 MR. SOUSA: Yes, there are. An OIC to
10 present.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is
12 that, sir?

13 MR. SOUSA: For the only charge, no
14 ABC manager or owner on premises, the OIC that
15 was agreed to is \$2,000 to be paid within 60 days
16 or the license will be suspended.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr.
18 Jones, it's my understanding there is an Offer in
19 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that
20 there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days. If
21 the fine is not payable in 60 days, the license
22 will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

1 Is this your understanding, sir, of
2 the Offer in Compromise?

3 MR. JONES: It is, sir.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
5 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
6 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

7 MR. JONES: Yes.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
9 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
10 that you are giving up your right to appeal this
11 matter?

12 MR. JONES: Yes, sir.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With this said,
14 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise
15 of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days be
16 accepted. If the fine is not payable in 60 days,
17 the license will be suspended until the fine has
18 been paid. Is there a second?

19 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
21 seconded the motion.
