8	MR. SOUSA: Christopher Sousa for the
9	District of Columbia.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
11	Mr. Sousa.
12	MR. O'BRIEN: Stephen O'Brien for the
13	respondent. I'm accompanied by Geoffrey Dawson,
14	who is the managing member of Penn Social.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
16	Mr. O'Brien.
17	MR. O'BRIEN: Good morning, sir.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
19	sir.
20	MR. DAWSON: Good morning.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr.
22	Sousa, are there any preliminary matters in this

1 case?

MR. SOUSA: Yes, it's my understanding that there is an OIC to present.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is the OIC, sir?

MR. SOUSA: For Charge 1, allowing the establishment to be used for unlawful purpose, the settlement is \$2,500 to be paid within 30 days or the license will be suspended.

For Charge 2, failure to follow the settlement agreement, that agreement is \$850 to be payable within 30 days or the license will be suspended.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. O'Brien, it's my understanding that there is an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that for Charge 1, there is a fine of \$2,500 payable in 30 days.

For Charge 2, there is also a fine of \$850 payable in 30 days. If the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license will be suspended until the fine is paid.

3	MR. O'BRIEN: Yes, except it's payable
4	today.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
6	Well, all right. So I will I stand corrected.
7	MR. O'BRIEN: And the licensee

9	hearing and to appeal.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
11	Well, if with that correction, I then make an
12	offer make a motion that the Offer in
13	Compromise of a fine of \$2,500 payable today for
14	Charge 1 and that a fine of \$850 payable today
15	for Charge 2, that if the fine is not payable
16	today, the license will be suspended until the
17	fine has been paid.
18	Is there a second?
19	MEMBER SHORT: Second.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
21	seconded the motion.
22	All those in favor say aye.

1	ALL: Aye.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
3	The matter passes 5-0-0.
4	MR. O'BRIEN: Thank you.
