MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of Pizzeria Paradiso please come forward? The parties in the matter of Pizzeria Paradiso.

This is case number 19-PRO-00029, Paradise SV, LLC, 4850 Massachusetts Avenue, Northwest, Suite 100, license number ABRA-109295. This is a retail class CR license renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and parking and residential property values. My name is La Verne Fletcher, conducting the Roll Call.

The microphone, $I$ don't know where the sound is coming from, but just don't move it, too loud for the court reporter. Thank you.

Introductions beginning with the applicant, please. If you -- you're the applicant for Pizzeria Paradiso? If you could please state your name and spell it for the record, please?

MS. GRESSER: Sure. Sure. It's Ruth
Gresser. R-U-T-H, last name is G-R-E-S-S-E-R.
MS. FLETCHER: G-R-E-S-S-E-R?

MS. GRESSER: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And Ms. Gresser, did you fill out the information on the contact sheet already?

MS. GRESSER: I did.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And present on behalf of the group of 37, 27.

MS. TRANG: Elizabeth Trang.
MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Trang, could you spell your name for the record, please?

MS. TRANG: Sure. E-L-I-Z-A-B-E-T-H, T-R-A-N-G

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Hi. And your name, sir?

MR. SMITH: Thomas Smith, T-H-O-M-A-S S-M-I-T-H

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Smith. Are there any other members from your protest group present today?

MR. SMITH: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: There's a microphone right in the middle. If you would just stand right between

Mr. Smith and Ms. Trang and state your name and spell it for the record?

MR. SMITH: We also have some proxies as well.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very much.
MR. KREBS: William Krebs, K-R-E-B, as in boy, $S$ as in Sam.

MS. FLETCHER: William, did you say K-R-EB?

MR. KREBS: S. One B.
MS. FLETCHER: That's it? Okay. Thank you. Anyone else?

MS. GATES: Alma Gates, A-L-M-A G-A-T-E-S.
MS. FLETCHER: G-A-T-E-S? Gates?
MS. GATES: Gates.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. VLCEK: Hi. Ann Vleck. And it's A-NN. Vleck is $V$ as in Victor, L-C-E-K.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. GREGORY: Richard Gregory, R-I-C-H-A-R-D G-R-E-G-O-R-Y.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Gregory.

MS. BRESNAHAN: Mary Bresnahan, M-A-R-Y B-R-E-S --

MS. FLETCHER: B like boy? I'm sorry.
MS. BRESNAHAN: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MS. BRESNAHAN: B-R-E-S-N-A-H-A-N.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. TRANG: Trung Trang, T-R-U-N-G T-R-A-N-G.

MS. FLETCHER: T-R-A?
MR. TRANG: N-G.
MS. FLETCHER: N-G?
MR. TRANG: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you --
MR. TRANG: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: -- very much. Everyone that just introduced themselves, signed the protest letter?

MR. SMITH: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Everybody signed the protest letter? Thank you. And, Mr. Smith, you mentioned that you have proxies?

MR. SMITH: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: I'll take those.
MR. SMITH: And we also have two by email here, digitally. Can we email those to you or what --

MS. FLETCHER: No. No. That's -- no. That won't be necessary because what's going to happen, just so you know, because at least five of you are present today, the entire group is going to be granted standing.

So, Mr. Smith, you'll be representing the group beyond today?

MR. SMITH: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: You'll be the designated representative? I'll take the proxies still. So the group is granted standing already just by the fact that at least five of you are present today. Thank you. I'll include these in the record.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Gresser, these are statements from other members of the protest group designating Mr. Smith to represent them in this matter.

You're welcome to take a look at these,
but that's -- for us, it's just for the record and I'll include these in the record. Thank you. Mr. Smith, your contact information is on that sheet?

MR. SMITH: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: There's something I want to mention to you, Mr. Smith. There are two signatures on your protest letter that are not legible.

It may not make that much of a difference at this stage since the entire group is granted standing, but let me take a crack at it. Give me one second.

MR. SMITH: Sure.
MS. FLETCHER: Let me get the letter, get the protest letter. So the -- one of them looks like maybe the last name is Lahey, it's on --

MR. SMITH: David Lahey.
MS. FLETCHER: Is that David? Okay. And the other one is William something.

MR. KREBS: Krebs.
MR. SMITH: That's Krebs.
MS. FLETCHER: Is that you?
MR. KREBS: Yes.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And it's David. Okay. Thank you. Thank you very much. The group of 27 has been granted standing.

I'm going to give you the date for a status hearing and a protest hearing and then we'll set a date for mediation. The status hearing is set for June 26th at 9:30. That's June 26th at 9:30.

At the status hearing, you'll just report to ABC Board the status, whether or not they had mediation and whether or not they settled their mediation. That's what happens at a status hearing.

The protest hearing is set for August 7. August 7, 2019, at 4:30 p.m., for the protest hearing. I will give you the next available day for a mediation.

MS. GRESSER: Can I ask a question?
MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MS. GRESSER: Are either of those dates flexible or no set period?

MS. FLETCHER: Those are the dates that the Board -- on which the Board is available at this point.

MS. GRESSER: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: If you need to change the date, you can petition our office to change --

MS. GRESSER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: -- the date, but if you do that, copy Mr. Smith --

MS. GRESSER: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: -- on the request.
MR. SMITH: And we'd be happy to accommodate in any way.

MS. FLETCHER: So then you can make it a joint request. Just, Mr. Smith, were you just saying you agree? And so yes. It can be changed under those circumstances.

But just for the purpose of the Roll Call Hearing, those'll be the dates but you can make a request to change them.

The next available date for mediation, the next available date for mediation is Monday, June 10, at 11:30 or 1:00.

But if you prefer something in the morning, I can move to another date, something earlier
in the morning, I should say.
MS. GRESSER: I can do a 1:00.
MR. SMITH: I would prefer if we could do something earlier in the morning.

MS. FLETCHER: Well, let's see. How about -- we can do something on Wednesday or -- well, let me just -- let me give you two dates.

We can do something on Wednesday, June 12 or Tuesday, June 18, at 9:00, 10:00, 10:30, either one of those days.

MR. SMITH: The June 18th works fine for me.

MS. FLETCHER: Does that work for you, Ms. Gresser?

MS. GRESSER: It does. Can we do the 10:30?

MR. SMITH: Yes. That would --
(Simultaneous speaking.)
MR. SMITH: -- be great. Yes. 10:30 would be great. And that doesn't mean that we can't talk before then. Correct?

MS. FLETCHER: Exactly. And then, if you
work something out before then, you reach a settlement agreement, you can let us know and we'll cancel the other proceedings, including the mediation.

Any questions at all? Okay. Well, if the matter's not resolved, we'll see you in mediation on the 18th at 10:30.

MS. GRESSER: Thank you very much.
MR. SMITH: Thank you very much.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you for coming. The Roll Call Hearing is concluded. Thank you.
