**ORDER GRANTING RECONSIDERATION**

---

The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board reviewed the records of the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration on April 24, 2024, and determined that the Caterer’s License held by Jamestown 1301 U LP, t/a Poppinmess Champagne & Dessert Bar, was improperly issued based on the ownership’s current holding of a Manufacturer’s License, which is prohibited by D.C. Official Code § 25-303(a)(1A). *See also* D.C. Code § 25-113(i) (defining a caterer as a retailer). Therefore, the Catering License, designated ABRA License No. 126665, was cancelled in accordance with Board Order No. 2024-184.

The license holder subsequently requested reinstatement of the cancelled license because it now intends to operate as a tavern. In light of the fact that the issuance of the caterer license does not prejudice any other license holder or any person seeking to file a caterer application.

**ORDER**

Therefore, the Board on this 28th day of August 2024, hereby **GRANTS** the motion for reinstatement and orders licensing to reissue the cancelled catering license. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
