ORDER CANCELLING PROTEST

The Application filed by Proper Exotic, LLC, t/a Proper Exotic (Applicant), for a New Medical Cannabis Retailer’s License, having been protested, was scheduled for a Roll Call Hearing before the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) Agent on March 3, 2025. Only the Applicant appeared for the hearing. The Board notes that the Applicant’s ownership withdrew the Application on January 29, 2025.¹ Therefore, the Roll Call Hearing and other protest proceedings in this matter are unnecessary.

¹ The Board’s records indicate that there may be a dispute amongst one or more owners, which may be why the Applicant as an entity formally withdrew the application but appeared at the hearing. At this time, it should be noted that the Board does not have sufficient information to make a definitive statement as to this issue but can only speculate.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board does hereby, this 12th day of March 2025, **CANCEL** the Protest based on the withdrawal of the Application. The Board notes that the Application in this matter will not be considered further unless the Application is revived.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board's approval of the withdrawal of the Application on January 29, 2025, is **AFFIRMED**.

The Board **ADVISES** the parties that the ANC has not been dismissed for a failure to appear where the Application was previously was withdrawn and the Roll Call Hearing was not necessary.

Pursuant to 23 DCMR §9723.1 (2003) any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 899 North Capitol Street, N.E., Suite 4200-B, Washington, D.C. 20002.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
