5 through the proposed technical rulemaking.

7 Official Code Section 25.211(b) to conduct a
8 public hearing and take comment on a proposed
9 rulemaking that makes several technical
10 amendments to Title 23 of the District of
11 Columbia Municipal Regulations, DCMR.

12 This rulemaking serves two purposes.
13 One, to update the language in Title 23 to
14 capture the requirements in the Omnibus Alcoholic
15 Beverage Regulation Amendment Act of 2018
16 effective October 30, 2018.

17 And two, to make other administrative
18 and technical changes unrelated to that act.

19 ABRA did not receive any notification
20 from witnesses in advance of today's hearing
21 regarding their desire to address the board.

22 Therefore the board will entertain
23 comments from anyone present today who wishes to
24 be heard. Please limit your comments to no more
25 than five minutes. If there is any time left of

1 the hearing the board will consider granting
2 additional time to individuals.

3 There is no one here today so it
4 doesn't appear that there are any members of the
5 public interested in testifying today.

6 However, the record will remain open
7 for interested parties to submit additional
8 comments by Friday, July 17, 2020 at 5 p.m.
