ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF RENEWAL APPLICATION

The Application filed by Social Restaurant Group, LLC, t/a Provision No. 14, (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on October 3, 2022.

On October 3, 2022, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order 2022-694.

On October 19, 2022, Naeem Mohd, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Mr. Mohd seeks reinstatement of the Application so the Applicant and MHNA can continue working towards a final Settlement Agreement.

Upon consideration of this uncontested request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 26th day of October 2022, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Social Restaurant Group, LLC, t/a Provision No. 14, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
