20	a protestant.
21	So there are two protestants in this
22	matter: ANC-5C and a Group of 5 or More.

1	And what that means is that the at
2	the upcoming Status Hearing, only the designated
3	representative for the group of individuals need
4	to appear and that's you, Ms. Odunsi.
5	So you are representing ANC-5C and the
6	group of individuals?
7	MS. ODUNSI: Yes.
8	AGENT FLETCHER: And that is stated in
9	the Protest Letter for the group. I'm just
10	stating it for the record. But it also says that
11	either you or Mr. Mullone
12	MS. ODUNSI: Yes.
13	AGENT FLETCHER: are the designated
14	representatives for the group of individuals.
15	MS. ODUNSI: Correct.

7	So the Single Member District protest
8	is actually dismissed.

15	these signatures to also be added to the group.

17	MS. YOHANNES: Okay.
18	MS. ODUNSI: signatures are what
19	was on the protest when people were signing.
20	MS. YOHANNES: That's what I thought.
21	I just wanted to

2	AGENT FLETCHER: You're correct.
3	MS. YOHANNES: the way I received
4	it from the from the
