ORDER ON PRAECIPE OF DISMISSAL

On November 23, 2020, the District of Columbia (Government) filed a Praecipe of Dismissal seeking dismissal of the charges listed in the Notices to Show Cause Hearing filed against Quara Ethiopian Fustion Restaurant, LLC, t/a Quara Ethiopian Fusion Resturant (Respondent), in Case Nos. 19-251-00014, 19-AUD-00018, 19-AUD-00041, 19-CMP-00091, 19-AUD-00122 and 20-AUD-00014. See ABRA Show Cause File Nos. 19-251-00014, 19-AUD-00018, 19-AUD-00041, 19-CMP-00091, 19-AUD-00122 and 20-AUD-00014.

The Government seeks to dismiss the charges because on November 18, 2020, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board cancelled the Respondent's License No. ABRA-105042. *See* Board Order No. 2020-878.

For these reasons, on this 24th day of November 2020, the Board hereby **ACKNOWLEDGES** receipt of the Government's Praecipe of Dismissal and **DISMISSES** Case Nos. 19-251-00014, 19-AUD-00018, 19-AUD-00041, 19-CMP-00091, 19-AUD-00122 and 20-AUD-00014 against the Respondent. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent and the Government.

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Pursuant to D.C. Official Code§ 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thilty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E StTeet, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
