AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in Quilox Restaurant and Lounge, please, come forward? The parties in the matter of Quilox Restaurant and Lounge. This is Case No. 19-PRO00100, Quilox, LLC, 7303 Georgia Avenue, N.W., License No. ABRA-114299. This is a Retailer Class CR new application.

The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet; residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety; real property values and over-concentration.

My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent.

Is the applicant present for Quilox? The applicant, the licensee? Is the licensee present at this time for Quilox?

I'll tell you why I'm asking. She called to say she -- about an hour ago, she was en route saying she might be running a little late. I'm just checking to see if she is here
yet, but I'll go through this exercise and see if she has arrived by then.

So I'm going to start with the protestants today. Present on behalf of the Group of 16, Mr. Carley?

MR. CARLEY: Yes.
AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. Carley, would you, please, state your name and spell it for the record?

MR. CARLEY: Andre, A-N-D-R-E, Carley, C-A-R-L-E-Y.

AGENT FLETCHER: And, Mr. Carley, you're representing the Group of $16 ?$

MR. CARLEY: Group of 5 or More, yes.
AGENT FLETCHER: Group of 5 or More. Are there any individuals from your group present today?

MR. CARLEY: Yes, there are.
AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Can they stand in front of the microphone, it's right there, and just state your name and spell it for the record, please. Good morning.

MS. HAZEL: Pauline Hazel, P-A-U-L-I-N-E H-A-Z-E-L.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Hazel. MS. WILLIAMS: Alice Williams, A-L-I-C-E W-I-L-L-I-A-M-S.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. WEBB: Judith Webb, J-U-D-I-T-H W-E-B-B.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. CHRISHON-SKINNER: Robbie, R-O-B-B-I-E, Chrishon, C-H-R-I-S-H-O-N, Skinner, S-K-I-N-N-E-R.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. RILEY: Geraldine Riley, G-E-R-A-L-D-I-N-E R-I-L-E-Y.

MR. SKINNER: James Skinner, J-A-M-E-S S-K-I-N-N-E-R.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Skinner.

So, Mr. Carley?
MR. CARLEY: Yes, ma'am?
AGENT FLETCHER: Can you --

MR. CARLEY: Nice to see you again, Ms. Fletcher.

AGENT FLETCHER: Hi, nice to see you again. There are a total of seven individuals from your group present today?

MR. CARLEY: Yes, ma'am.
AGENT FLETCHER: And that means that--
MR. CARLEY: Well --
AGENT FLETCHER: Is there one more?
MR. CARLEY: -- one went to move her car, but --

AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. So I'll make that eight.

MR. CARLEY: Eight, okay. It's what now?

MS. HAZEL: She said 10.
MR. CARLEY: 10? There are 10 of us?
MS. HAZEL: Um-hum.
MR. CARLEY: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. So, Mr.
Carley, how many is there present today?
MR. CARLEY: Gosh, one two --

MS. HAZEL: 10.
MR. CARLEY: -- 10. I'll take your word for it. 10, okay.

AGENT FLETCHER: And so what I'm going to do, $I$ have -- so is there anybody in the room right now that hasn't stated their name for the record?

MR. CARLEY: No. Not for the Party of 5.

AGENT FLETCHER: Not for -- I'm sorry, for the Party of $16 ?$

MR. CARLEY: Not for the Party of 5, no.

AGENT FLETCHER: So I'm going to go with 10. There are eight here and you are indicating, Mr. Carley, that there are two more coming.

MR. CARLEY: Carolyn Kornegay should be coming.

AGENT FLETCHER: On their way in. Okay. So I'm going to make that 10 individuals from your group present today, which means that
your group has full standing because at least five individuals were present.

And at the upcoming Status Hearing only you need to appear.

MR. CARLEY: Right.
AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. Present on behalf of the Concerned Neighbors, Inc.?

MR. CARLEY: That's you, Trudy.
MS. JONES: Okay. Gertrude Trudy Jones, that's G-E-R-T-R-U-D-E "T-R-U-D-Y" last name Jones, J-O-N-E-S, president of Concerned Neighbors, Inc.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much. The Concerned Neighbors, Inc. does have standing as a protestant.

And present on behalf of the Shepherd Park Citizens Association?

MS. JEFFERSON: Naima Jefferson. It's spelled N-A-I-M-A and the last name is J-E-F-F-E-R-S-O-N.

## AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.

MS. JEFFERSON: And I'm president of

Shepherd Park Citizens Association.
AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
Jefferson.
MS. EDWARDS: And Paula, P-A-U-L-A, Edwards, E-D-W-A-R-D-S.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
Edwards. And you are also a designated representative for the Shepherd Park?

MS. EDWARDS: Yes.
AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
MR. CARLEY: Ms. Fletcher, I'm also a representative of CNI as well. Should I state that as well?

AGENT FLETCHER: Yeah. I'll add that.
MR. CARLEY: Yeah. It's in the resolution packet.

AGENT FLETCHER: It's in the protest? Oh, you sure are, yeah.

MR. CARLEY: Yeah.
AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. So I have that, Mr. Carley. I actually have you down as the second representative for the Concerned

Neighbors, Inc.
MR. CARLEY: Yes, ma'am.
MS. JEFFERSON: Ms. Fletcher, we have a third designated representative. He is not feeling well.

AGENT FLETCHER: You sure do, that is Carl Bergman.

MS. JEFFERSON: Yes, you have met him before.

AGENT FLETCHER: I did. I remember him.

MS. JEFFERSON: He is an elderly gentleman.

AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.
MS. JEFFERSON: He just told me he is not feeling very well.

AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Thank you. That's Carl, C-A-R-L, Bergman, B-E-R-G-M-A-N. Mr. Bergman is also a designated representative for the Shepherd Park Citizens Association, which does have standing as a protestant.

Is the applicant present for Quilox?

Okay. We are going to keep moving along. I have a couple more things to do. I'll see if she is here when we are done.

I'm going to set a date for the Status Hearing and the Protest Hearing.

The Status Hearing is set for October 9 at 9:30 a.m., that's the Status Hearing, October 9 at 9:30 a.m.

MS. JEFFERSON: Excuse me, Ms.
Fletcher?
AGENT FLETCHER: Yes?
MS. JEFFERSON: We are running into the same issue we ran before about the holiday.

AGENT FLETCHER: Oh.
MS. JEFFERSON: Remember we ran into that issue with the other two establishments.

MR. CARLEY: Yes.
AGENT FLETCHER: I do remember. So what I'm going to do -- the October 9 date is the date that I'm going to give you, because that was the next available date on the Board's calendar, so that's the date they gave me.

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: It's going to change though, right, the October date?

MS. JEFFERSON: If you allow it to.
AGENT FLETCHER: So we will -- so what is going to happen, the -- Ms. Jefferson, you can initiate the request for the Board to change the date.

MS. JEFFERSON: For the Motion of Continuance?

AGENT FLETCHER: For the Motion of Continuance.

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: And then just copy all - -

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: -- including -- do you have the contact information for the applicant, Ms. Quilox?

MS. JEFFERSON: Yes.
AGENT FLETCHER: I mean, she is not -MS. JEFFERSON: Yes.

AGENT FLETCHER: -- not Ms. Quilox, the applicant.

MS. JEFFERSON: Yes.
AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. And so once you submit that request, then the Board will make the adjustment to the date for the Status Hearing.

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: The Protest Hearing is set for November 6, that's November 6 at 1:30 p.m.

I can't set a date for mediation because the applicant is not here, so my question to you is whether or not you would want to wait any longer for her to appear? That's strictly up to you.

MR. CARLEY: No.
MS. JEFFERSON: No.
AGENT FLETCHER: The application --
MS. JEFFERSON: They are late.
MR. CARLEY: No, never mind. Yeah, that's to decide, but yeah.

AGENT FLETCHER: -- is dismissed.
MR. CARLEY: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: The Board will issue an order dismissing the application. She called, but you are not required to wait. It's about 10:20.

And once you get the order, once she-I'm saying she because the person that called was a female.

MR. CARLEY: Right.
AGENT FLETCHER: Once she gets the order, she will have 10 days to ask the Board for reinstatement. You will be kept -- you will get a copy of the order. And if she does request reinstatement, you will have an opportunity to be in agreement with it or not.

But as of today, the application, the new license application is dismissed.

MR. CARLEY: Okay.
MS. JEFFERSON: I have a clarifying question.

AGENT FLETCHER: Um-hum.

MS. JEFFERSON: In the event the Board determines that it can be reinstated, is the schedule maintained or do you adjust the schedule as well?

AGENT FLETCHER: It's going to -- it will stay the same maybe. And the reason for that is because it depends on when the Board -when her request for reinstatement goes onto the Board's Agenda.

The dates could change. I'm just going to leave those dates on the record, but they could change, because when she gets the order, she has 10 days to seek reinstatement. If she waits until the 10th day, the dates will change. And so they could change, so they could.

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: And so the October 9 date may change because -- just by, you know, depending on when she seeks reinstatement.

MS. JEFFERSON: Is she required to placard again?

AGENT FLETCHER: Maybe. Sometimes
that happens.
MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: The Board decides whether or not they need to be replacarded. That happens sometimes. I see somebody coming into the hearing room. I don't know if that's the applicant or not. I'll see if that is.

MR. CARLEY: One of our members.
AGENT FLETCHER: Oh, those are two of your people?

MR. CARLEY: That's Carolyn Kornegay.
MS. JEFFERSON: Kornegay, yeah.
MR. CARLEY: And also just -- I didn't answer the phone, but Sarah Green was supposed to be here, too. She is one of the Party of 5 that was supposed to come.

AGENT FLETCHER: Well, I'll take the names of these two individuals who just came in.

MR. CARLEY: Yes. All right.
AGENT FLETCHER: Those are two of your -- and so --

MR. CARLEY: Carol just called, but I
couldn't answer because we are here.
AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. You can --
MR. CARLEY: Ms. Kornegay, you can
state your name for the record and write your name down here.

AGENT FLETCHER: If you just state your name and spell it for the record right into that microphone.

MS. KORNEGAY: Carolyn Kornegay, K-O-R-N-E-G-A-Y.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
Kornegay. Thank you very much.
Mr. Carley?
MR. CARLEY: Yes, ma'am?
AGENT FLETCHER: Was that other person part of your group as well?

MR. CARLEY: No.
AGENT FLETCHER: It really doesn't matter too much. I mean, you have already been granted full standing.

MR. CARLEY: Yeah, no, no, she was not here.

AGENT FLETCHER: And so it's not going to really change anything.

MR. CARLEY: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: Except it would just be on the record that they are here.

MR. CARLEY: That they are here. Okay. Sign in.

AGENT FLETCHER: But, Ms. Jefferson?
MS. JEFFERSON: Yes?
AGENT FLETCHER: So the Board could decide to have her replacard. Sometimes that's the decision they make. They can make it if they want to.

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: And so we will let you know about that, too.

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: So thank you for coming. The application is dismissed and we will keep you posted.

MS. JEFFERSON: Okay.
AGENT FLETCHER: If she comes before--
