14	applicant, please. Good morning.
15	MS. SASSO: My name is Bridget Sasso,
16	B-R-I-D-G-E-T Sasso, S-A-S-S-O. I'm the owner of
17	Radici.
18	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Sasso.
19	Ms. Sasso, you have already put your contact
20	information on that sheet?
21	MS. SASSO: Yes.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

1	MS. SASSO: Um-hum.
2	AGENT FLETCHER: And present on behalf
3	of the ANC?
4	MR. JAYARAMAN: There is two of us
5	here, Your madam.
6	MR. SROUFE: I'm Gerald Sroufe,
7	Commissioner in 6B02.
8	AGENT FLETCHER: Excuse me, could you
9	spell your name?
10	MR. SROUFE: Yes. The last name is S-
11	R-O-U-F-E.
12	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
13	MR. JAYARAMAN: And I an Chander
14	Jayaraman, C-H-A-N-D-E-R, last name J-A-Y-A-R-A-
15	M-A-N. I also appear as the Chairman of the ABC
16	Committee for ANC-6B.
17	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
18	Jayaraman. Which one of you are going to be the
19	designated representative for this case?
20	MR. JAYARAMAN: I will be.
21	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
22	ANC-6B has standing as a protestant.

1	We need to set a date for mediation,
2	a Status Hearing and a Protest Hearing.
3	The date for the Status Hearing is
4	July 10. July 10 at 9:30 a.m. for the Status
5	Hearing.
6	MR. JAYARAMAN: I would like to see if
7	the applicant is available on June 24th, Monday,
8	June 24th for mediation? Oh, right, right. What
9	date are you leaving?
10	MS. SASSO: I leave on Thursday evening
11	the 22nd.
12	MR. JAYARAMAN: Okay. Perfect. So
13	how about the 20th?
14	Ms. sasso: 20th.
15	AGENT FLETCHER: So are we setting a
16	date for mediation? Is that the date we are
17	looking at now?
18	Ms. sasso: Uh-huh.
19	MR. JAYARAMAN: Yes, ma'am.
20	AGENT FLETCHER: SO
21	MR. JAYARAMAN: We fully expect to be
22	able to resolve any issues and our full ANC meets

1 next Tuesday, so we are fully expecting to 2 withdraw our current protest. But in order to retain our standing, we are here before you 3 4 today. 5 AGENT FLETCHER: The mediation time 6 available on June 20 would be 1:00 in the afternoon. So I'll set the mediation for 1:00 in 7 8 the afternoon. 9 I understand that it may not be 10 necessary. 11 MR. JAYARAMAN: Right. 12 AGENT FLETCHER: I'll give you the 13 date for the Protest Hearing in case that is 14 necessary. July 10 is actually the Status 15 Hearing, July 10 at 9:30. 16 The Protest Hearing is set for August 17 14, August 14 at 1:30 for the Protest Hearing. 18 We will cancel all those dates if the 19 matter is resolved. 20 Any questions at all? Okay. Well, 21 thank you for coming. The Roll Call Hearing is
