**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND
REINSTATING LICENSE**

On December 4, 2024, the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-119836 held by 508 K Street Rebel Taco, LLC, t/a Rebel Taco (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to pay the safe-keeping fee for his license. *See* Board Order No. 2024-914.

On December 10, 2024, Sean T. Morris, Counsel on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-119836. In support of his request for reinstatement, Mr. Morris indicated that the internal issues that caused the Petitioner to miss the deadline to make payment for his safekeeping fee have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner pays the safekeeping fee.

Accordingly, it is this 15th day of January 2025, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on December 4, 2024 , be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-119836 be **REINSTATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Petitioner.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202-879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
