3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of Red Lounge Hookah please come
5 forward, the parties in the matter of Red Lounge
6 Hookah? This is Case #19-PRO-00133, Salma, LLC,
7 2013 A 14th Street NW; License #ABRA-076011.

8 This is a Retailer Class CT License
9 Renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact
10 on peace, order and quiet, residential parking
11 and vehicular and pedestrian safety and real
12 property values.

13 My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting
14 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent.
15 Introductions, beginning with the applicant,
16 please?

17 MR. HUNTER: Good morning. Dean
18 Hunter for the applicant, Salma, LLC, Amadou Bah,
19 owner.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Hunter, would you
21 spell your name for the record, please?

23 MS. FLETCHER: And present on behalf
