4 the matter of Reveler's Hours, please, come  
5 forward? This is Case No. 19-PRO-0005, Sons of--

6 MR. TYLER: Anacreon.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. Anacreon,  
8 1773-1777 Columbia Road, N.W., License No. ABRA-  
9 112246. This is a Retailer Class CR new  
10 application.

11 The protest issues are adverse impact  
12 on peace, order and quiet.

13 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting  
14 the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent.

17 MR. MINORA: Matthew Minora from the  
18 Law Firm Mallios & O'Brien, ABC-licensed counsel  
19 of record.

20 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Minora,  
21 could you spell your name for the record, please?

22 MR. MINORA: Sure. Last name is M-I-

1 N-O-R-A.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And your  
3 name, ma'am, please?

4 MR. TYLER: Jill, J-I-L-L, Tyler, T,  
5 as in Tom, Y-L-E-R.

6 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.  
7 Present on behalf of ANC-1C?

8 MR. GUTHRIE: Ted Guthrie, T-E-D G-U-  
9 T-H-R-I-E.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.  
11 Guthrie. And the Kalorama Citizens Association?

12 MR. JAMES: Good morning. Denis  
13 James, Denis spelled with one N.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. James.  
15 ANC-1C and the Kalorama Citizens Association has  
16 standing as a protestant.

17 We need to set a date for a mediation,  
18 a Status Hearing and a Protest Hearing. I'll  
19 give you the date for the Status and Protest  
20 Hearing first.

21 The date of the Status Hearing is  
22 March 6th.

1 MR. GUTHRIE: Excuse me?

2 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry, the date  
3 of the Status Hearing is March 6th.

4 MR. GUTHRIE: 6th?

5 AGENT FLETCHER: March 6, uh-huh.

11 MR. MINORA: Okay.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: The Protest Hearing  
13 is set for April 3rd, April 3, 2019 at 1:30 p.m.

14 I'll give you the next available date  
15 for mediation. The next available day is  
16 February -- if anybody wanted to come later this  
17 week, February 7 is available. If not, we can  
18 just move to the following week.

19 MR. GUTHRIE: Let's move to the  
20 following week.

21 MR. MINORA: Sure.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. So for the

1 following week, Thursday, February 14 is  
2 available, Valentine's Day at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00,  
3 1:00, 2:00?

4 MR. MINORA: How about 11:00?

5 MR. JAMES: That works for me.

6 AGENT FLETCHER: That's good?

7 MR. MINORA: That's good.

8 MR. TYLER: Yes.

9 AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. James is that  
10 good for you?

11 MR. JAMES: Yes.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: Mediation is set for  
13 11:00 on February 14. Okay.

14 MR. TYLER: Thank you so much.

15 MR. MINORA: Thank you.

16 MR. GUTHRIE: Thank you.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: You're welcome. The  
18 Roll Call Hearing is concluded. Thank you.
