that the group of abutting property owners 1 2 submitted, it does say that "It is respectfully requested that if I cannot make it to the Roll 3 4 Call Hearing, that a designated representative 5 from 3210 Grace Street, N.W., represent my opposition herein." 6 So I'm going to accept that as you 7 8 representing the group. 9 MS. DU TOIT: Thank you. 10 AGENT FLETCHER: So a name was not stated, but it's clear that it can be you and I 11 12 will accept you as the designated representative. 13 There are two protestants, ANC-2E and 14 the Group of 9 abutting property owners. The board of directors of the condo 15 16 association does not have standing and is 17 dismissed as a protestant. 18 We need to set a date for a mediation, 19 Status Hearing and a Protest Hearing. I'll give 20 you the date for the Status and Protest Hearing 21 first.
