3 AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in  
4 the matter of Roha Liquors please come forward?  
5 This is Case Number 18-PRO-00035, LAL, Inc.

6 Excuse me, Mr. Kim, can you all speak  
7 outside or - thank you.

8 620 K Street, NW, License Number is  
9 060496. This is a Retailer Class A license  
10 renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact  
11 on peace, order, and quiet.

12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'm  
13 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's  
14 agent. Introductions beginning with the  
15 Applicant, please.

16 MR. ARAGAW: My name is Kassa, K-A-S-  
17 S-A

18 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry, K-A --

19 MR. ARAGAW: S-S-A

20 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.

21 MR. ARAGAW: -- first name, last name,  
22 Aragaw, A-R-A-G-A-W.

1                   AGENT FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very  
2 much. And, Mr. Mpras, if you could state your  
3 name and spell it for the record.

4                   MR. MPRAS: Yes, Emanuel Mpras. I'm  
5 representing the Applicant.

6                   AGENT FLETCHER: And could you spell  
7 it please?

8                   MR. MPRAS: E-M-A-N-U-E-L.

9                   AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.

10                  MR. MPRAS: Last name, M-P-R-A-S.

11                  AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.  
12 And present on behalf of ANC 4D?

13                  MS. ROTH: Yes. My name is Nancy  
14 Roth, R-O-T-H.

15                  AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Roth.

16                  MS. ROTH: 4D 01 is my single member  
17 district.

18                  AGENT FLETCHER: ANC 4D has standing  
19 as a protestant.

20                  MS. ROTH: Thank you.

21                  AGENT FLETCHER: We need to set a date  
22 for a mediation, a status hearing, and a protest

1 hearing. I'll give you the dates of the status  
2 and protest hearing first. The date for the  
3 status hearing is June 27th.

4 MS. ROTH: Two seven?

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, June 27.

6 MS. ROTH: Yes, ma'am.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: June 27 at 9:30 a.m.

8 The protest hearing is set for July 25, July 25  
9 at 4:30.

10 MS. ROTH: I'm sorry, would you repeat  
11 the -

12 AGENT FLETCHER: The status?

13 MS. ROTH: -- the time on the  
14 mediation?

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Oh, we haven't set  
16 the mediation yet. But the status hearing on  
17 June 27 is set for 9:30.

18 MS. ROTH: Oh, I beg your pardon, and  
19 that time is when?

20 AGENT FLETCHER: 9:30.

21 MS. ROTH: Thank you, ma'am.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: You're welcome. And

1 the protest hearing is set for July 25, 2018, at  
2 4:30. That's the protest hearing.

3 The next available date for mediation  
4 is, let's see, we can do June 11 at 11:30 or June  
5 14, which is that Thursday, at 9:00, 10:00,  
6 11:00, 1:00. Pretty much any time is available  
7 on June 14. On June 11, it's only 11:30.

8 MS. ROTH: The 11th and the 14th?

9 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. And the 11th is  
10 on a Monday. 11:30 is available on that day.

11 MS. ROTH: Okay. I'm sorry, what was  
12 the - did we set an hour?

13 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry, what was  
14 that, Ms. Roth?

15 MS. ROTH: Did we set a time on the  
16 11th?

17 AGENT FLETCHER: No, that's the date  
18 that's available. So we're setting a date for  
19 mediation, but we're going to set it on a day and  
20 a time that's convenient for both you and the  
21 Applicant.

22 MS. ROTH: Okay.

1                   AGENT FLETCHER: So Monday the 11th is  
2 available at 11:30 if -

3                   MS. ROTH: 11:30?

4                   AGENT FLETCHER: Or Thursday the 14th  
5 is available at 9:00, 10:00, 10:30, 11:30.

6                   MR. MPRAS: Monday is fine for us.

7                   MS. ROTH: Okay.

8                   MR. MPRAS: Better sooner than later.

9                   MS. ROTH: I guess I would prefer  
10 earlier in day if you could manage that.

11                   AGENT FLETCHER: Well, the 14th is -

12                   MS. ROTH: I would do, if the 11th  
13 works out, I would do that. Let me just do that,  
14 okay.

15                   AGENT FLETCHER: So that's your  
16 preference. Mr. Mpras, 11:30?

17                   MR. MPRAS: Yes, ma'am. I'd like to  
18 meet sooner than later, so -

19                   AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. And, Ms. Roth,  
20 you can come at 11:30 on Monday, the 11th?

21                   (No audible response.)

22                   AGENT FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

1 MR. MPRAS: The 11th, correct?

2 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.

3 MR. MPRAS: Okay, great.

4 AGENT FLETCHER: The 11th at 11:30 for  
5 mediation. Ms. Roth, did you have any questions  
6 about anything else, any other dates?

7 MS. ROTH: No.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. The roll call  
9 hearing is concluded. Thank you for coming. See  
10 you then.
