The Offer in 3 4 Compromise that the parties have to present to 5 the Board consists as follows: A fine of \$2,000 payable within 60 6 days and if the fine is not paid within 60 days, 7 8 the license will be suspended until payment is 9 received. That is the OIC. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Dietz, it 11 is my understanding that there is an Offer in 12 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days. 13 If 14 the fine is not payable in 60 days, the license 15 will be suspended until compliance. 16 Is that your understanding, sir, of 17 the Offer in Compromise? 18 MR. DIETZ: That's our understanding 19 and it's our agreement. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your 21 client aware that by accepting an Offer in 22 Compromise --

16	this said, I then make a motion that the Offer in
17	Compromise of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days
18	be accepted. If the fine is not payable in 60
19	days, the license will be suspended until the
20	fine has been paid. Is there a second?
