#### ORDER ON SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that Moonkor Corporation, t/a S.E. Market (Licensee), and ANC 6B have entered into a Settlement Agreement (Agreement), dated April 10, 2018, that governs the operation of the Licensee's establishment.

The Agreement has been reduced to writing and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. The Licensee and Chairperson Daniel Ridge, on behalf of ANC 6B, are signatories to the Agreement.

Accordingly, it is this 23rd day of May, 2018, **ORDERED** that:

 The above-referenced Settlement Agreement submitted by the parties to govern the operations of the Licensee's establishment is APPROVED and INCORPORATED as part of this Order, except for the following modification:

Subsection 2(e) (Nature of the Business) – This Subsection shall be modified to read as follows: "Applicant will not sell or provide go cups, single servings of ice if requested, utilize clear (without any color) plastic bags for customers to carry alcohol from the subject Premises."

The parties have agreed to this modification.

- 2. This Settlement Agreement replaces and supersedes previous Settlement Agreements between the parties; and
- 3. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee and ANC 6B.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).

# SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 6B

and

Moonkor Corporation, t/a S.E. Market

Pursuant to this Settlement Agreement, ("Agreement"), by and between Moonkor Corporation, t/a S.E. Market ("Applicant") and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6B ("ANC6B"), effective as of the date of its adoption by ANC6B, the parties hereby agree to be legally bound by the terms and conditions of this Agreement, superseding and replacing all previous agreements with respect to Applicant as it relates to its application for Substantial Change of its current Class "B" License (ABRA-089011) ("License"), now pending before the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Regulatory Administration ("ABRA"), for conduct of business located at 1500 Independence Avenue SE, Washington, DC 20003 ("Premises").

WHEREAS Applicant has applied before ABRA to effect, and is seeking its approval of a Substantial Change to its current License for the Premises; and

WHEREAS Applicant and ANC6B wish to voluntarily and mutually memorialize the terms and conditions upon which ANC6B has agreed to support the Applicant's License, pursuant to the provisions of D.C. Code § 25-446, for the operation and maintenance of Applicant's business in such a manner as to further promote the security, sanitation, peace, order and quiet of the neighborhood in a manner that ANC6B deems to be in the best interests of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS ANC6B hereby supports the Applicant's License upon the agreement of Applicant to execute and abide by the terms and conditions hereof;

It is THEREFORE AGREED AND RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. Recitals Incorporated. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Nature of the Business. Applicant will manage and operate, at the address, a business that is regularly used for the sale of groceries, prepared food and alcoholic beverages. Applicant will operate a Retailer's Class A license under the following provisions:
  - a. Applicant will comply with all laws and regulations governing the operations of the business;
  - b. Applicant will not divide a manufacturer's package of more than one container of beer, malt liquor, or ale to sell an individual container of the package if the container is less than 70 ounces. Further, Applicant will not sell spirits (liquor) that are less than a half-pint in volume;
  - c. Applicant will discourage the illegal public consumption of alcohol inside, on the sidewalk adjacent or around the immediate area and will participate in an ABC Boardapproved course in alcoholic beverage sales management;

- Applicant will operate and maintain operational security cameras to record and monitor activity in front of the establishment;
- e. Applicant will not sell or provide cups, single servings of ice and utilize clear (without any color) plastic bags for customers to carry alcohol from the subject Premises; and,
- f. Applicant agrees to post this Settlement Agreement alongside the Applicant's ABC License.
- g. Any change from this model concerning hours of sales will be of concern to neighboring residents and businesses.

### 3. Hours of Operation and Sales

Applicant's hours of operation shall be as follows:

Monday through Sunday:

8 a.m. - 12:00 midnight

Applicant's hours of sales of alcohol shall be as follows:

Monday through Sunday:

8 a.m. - 12:00 Midnight

- 4. Signage, Noise, and Privacy. Applicant will strictly comply with D.C. Official Code and will prohibit and prevent loitering, rowdiness, panhandling, and criminal activity within 100 feet of the Premises, to the best of its ability by:
  - a. Affix a "No Loitering/Panhandling" sign of the outside of the establishment.
  - Posting a notice kept in good repair and visible from point of entry, a sign which states:
    - i. the minimum age requirement for purchases of alcohol, and
    - ii. the obligation of the patron to produce a valid identification document in order to purchase alcohol
  - Requesting loiterers to move on whenever they are observed outside of the establishment.
  - d. Calling MPD to remove loiterers if they refuse Applicant's request to move on or if illegal activity is observed.
  - Keeping a written record of dates and times when MPD is called for assistance.
     Applicant's log shall be provided to the Board upon request.
  - f. Applicant will ensure timely disposal of trash that is the least disruptive to the neighbors and that commercial trash pick will only take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- 5. Public Space Cleanliness and Maintenance. Applicant will maintain the public space adjacent to the establishment in a clean and litter-free condition by:
  - a. Exercising due diligence to prevent and or rid vermin infestation in and around the

establishment, including following the recommendations and guidelines of the Vector Control Division of the Department of Public Work.

- b. Keeping its entire property and the sidewalk (up to and including the curb), tree box(es), curb, and alley clean and free of litter, bottles, and other debris in compliance with D.C. Code and Municipal Regulations. Applicant shall police these areas sufficiently to assure that refuse and other materials are promptly removed.
- c. Applicant shall ensure that the area around the dumpster is kept clean at all times and the dumpster is placed such that it does not encroach on the abutting property owners and that no garbage is placed on the abutting property or public space. Applicant shall ensure that no trash is placed outside the establishment other than in a fully-closed dumpster or compactor. Applicant shall ensure that the doors and/or lids on all dumpsters or compactors are fully closed at all times. Applicant shall not place trash in its dumpster or compactor in any manner that would prevent the full closure of the dumpster or compactor. Applicant shall ensure that all dumpsters and compactors used are properly maintained and replaced when damaged.
- Compliance with ABRA Regulations. Applicant promises that it shall abide by all Alcoholic Beverage Regulations Administration (ABRA) regulations regarding the ownership of the license and all other provisions applicable to liquor licenses.
