next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-
00438, Saint Yves, License No. 99876.
Will the parties, please, approach and
identify themselves for the record, please?
MR. SOUSA: Christopher Sousa for the
District of Columbia.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
again, Mr. Sousa.
MR. DIOMI: Egie Diomi for Dos
Ventures doing business as Saint Yves.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr.
Diomi, now, I know I have seen you before, but
did you do you have and I don't recall if
this was done before, have you provided the
Agency with a letter stating that you are
authorized to represent this establishment at
this hearing today, sir?
MR. DIOMI: Actually not yet, but I do
have the letter.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What? I mean, 2 you have it with you? MR. DIOMI: 3 Yes. 4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, can you 5 show it to Mr. Sousa? And then we will get a 6 copy, sir. 7 MR. DIOMI: Sure. 8 MR. SOUSA: I'm okay. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. So we 10 will get a copy, sir. All right. Are there any 11 preliminary matters in this case? 12 MR. SOUSA: It's my understanding that 13 an Offer in Compromise has been reached between 14 the parties. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is the 16 Offer in Compromise, sir? 17 MR. SOUSA: The Offer in Compromise as 18 to Charge 1, no ABC manager, is a warning. 19 As to Charge 2, the license not 20 conspicuously posted, that charge is being dismissed. 21 22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, so

what is the --1 2 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: A warning. MR. SOUSA: A warning for Charge 1 and 3 4 a dismissal for Charge 2. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 5 Oh, okay, All right. All right. 6 sorry. So, Mr. Diomi, it's my understanding 7 that there is an Offer in Compromise and the 8 9 Offer in Compromise is that for Charge 1 a 10 warning will be issued and Charge 2 that there will be a dismissal. 11 12 Is this your understanding, sir, of 13 the Offer in Compromise? 14 MR. DIOMI: Yes, sir. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 16 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that 17 you are giving up your right to a hearing? 18 MR. DIOMI: Yes, I am. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also 20 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, 21 that you are giving up your right to appeal this 22 matter?
