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**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND  
REINSTATING LICENSE**

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On July 27, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-086790 held by Good Neighbors, LLC, t/a Salt & Pepper (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to renew its license by July 12, 2022, the extension deadline for all Retailer's Class CR licenses. *See* Board Order No. 2022-515.

On August 1, 2022, Matthew T. Minora, Esq., on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-086790. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from renew its license have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner submits the renewal application and pays the license fees.

Accordingly, it is this 3rd day of August 2022, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on July 27, 2022, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-086790 be **REINSTATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Petitioner submit the renewal application and pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010).

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
