## **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE**

On June 21, 2022, Wyoming Cube & Bale, LLC, t/a SandboX Restaurant (Applicant), filed its initial Application for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License, which was protested by the Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2E and the Citizens Association of Georgetown. *See* ABRA Licensing File No. ABRA-110062; ABRA Protest File No. 22-PRO-00070.

On September 14, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) dismissed the initial Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2022-653.

On October 5, 2022, the Board issued an Order to Cease and Desist against the Applicant pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1606.5, for failure to file a Request for Reinstatement of its Renewal Application within ten (10) days from the date of Order No. 2022-691, dated September 14, 2022, and for failure to file a second renewal application. The Applicant did not respond to the Order to Cease and Desist. *See* Board Order No. 2022-691.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 26th day of October 2022, that Wyoming Cube & Bale, LLC's License No. ABRA-110062 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code§ 25-433(d)(l), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
