20	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr.
21	Elliott, did you say Robert Elliott lawyer? What
22	did you say the last thing? You said your name

CRUSE: Karen Cruse representing 19 the Citizens Association of Georgetown. 20 AGENT FLETCHER: Good morning, Ms. 21 Cruse. Would you spell your name for the court Thank you. 22 reporter?

8	initial Roll Call Hearing was on August 6, 2018
9	at which time the Citizens Association of
10	Georgetown was granted standing and so you have
11	been grandfathered in for today.
12	MS. CRUSE: Thank you.
13	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Cruse.
14	Present on behalf of Edward Emes?
15	MS. EMES: No. Yes, Elizabeth Emes.
16	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Mr. Emes?
17	MS. EMES: Mr. Emes couldn't be here.
18	He is not well.
19	AGENT FLETCHER: Oh, you know, you
20	were grandfathered in as well. You know that
21	your group was also grandfathered in by the Board
22	and so

1	MS. EMES: Everybody has to show up?	
2	AGENT FLETCHER: You are grandfathered	
3	in 100 percent your group is grandfathered in,	
4	because you were here for the August 6th Roll Call	
5	Hearing.	
6	MS. EMES: Does everybody need to show	
7	up again?	
8	AGENT FLETCHER: Today would have been	
9	the date that if you hadn't shown up today,	
10	you would have been granted standing anyway,	
11	because you were you requested to be	
12	grandfathered in because you were here on August	
13	6th.	
14	MS. EMES: You know, I called and they	
15	said we had to be here, all of us.	
16	AGENT FLETCHER: I don't know what	
17	I	
18	MS. EMES: There were certain ones	
19	that couldn't come today, had to go to the Status	
20	Hearing.	
21	AGENT FLETCHER: Well, let's see, when	
22	we left off, the last time I don't have that	

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1 folder with me, Ms. Emes, but the only way that 2 would be the case is if when you were here last time on August 6th of 2018, do you recall if you--3 4 if at least five people from your group were 5 present? Yes, they were. 6 MS. EMES: So then you did not 7 AGENT FLETCHER: 8 need -- you -- it's okay that no one else is here 9 but you. And if you were not here, you would 10 still be granted standing, your group, I mean, 11 because the Board grandfathered you in. 12 And that's great to know MS. EMES: 13 because whoever I called on the phone said we all 14 had to be here. So I wonder if 15 AGENT FLETCHER: 16 somebody knew that the Board had grandfathered 17 you in. 18 MS. EMES: No. 19 Well, it's nice to AGENT FLETCHER: 20 see you anyway. 21 MS. EMES: Thanks. 22 AGENT FLETCHER: Is anyone else here

1 from your group or just you today? 2 MS. EMES: Yes. Rosalinda Rivera. 3 MS. RIVERA: 4 AGENT FLETCHER: Okav. 5 MS. RIVERA: Rosalinda Rivera. Thank you. 6 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm just 7 going to -- I'll just make a note of it anyway. 8 Ms. Rivera, since your name has been 9 mentioned, could you state it and spell it for the record right into that microphone next to Ms. 10 11 Cruse? If you could state your name? 12 MS. RIVERA: My name is spelled R-O-S-13 A-L-I-N-D-A and my last name spelled R-I-V-E-R-A. 14 AGENT FLETCHER: How is the last name spelled? 15 16 MS. RIVERA: R-I-V-E-R-A. 17 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very 18 much. I just made a note that you were present 19 today. Thank you. And on behalf of ANC-2E? 20 21 MR. MURPHY: Rick Murphy. 22 AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. Murphy, ANC-2E

does have standing as a protestant. And so there 1 2 is a third group this time, a fourth group, a Group of Five. Mr. Dower? 3 4 MR. DOWER: Yes. 5 AGENT FLETCHER: Are you representing that group? 6 7 MR. DOWER: I am. 8 Would you state your AGENT FLETCHER: 9 name into the microphone and spell it for the 10 record, please? 11 MR. DOWER: My name is Benjamin Dower, 12 B-E-N-J-A-M-I-N D-O-W-E-R. 13 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. Anybody 14 else from your group present today, Mr. Dower? 15 MR. DOWER: No. 16 AGENT FLETCHER: That's fine. You may 17 know that that means that at the upcoming Status 18 Hearing at least four more need to appear, but 19 for the purpose of today, the group is granted 20 conditional standing. 21 And conditional standing is being 22 granted to the Group of Five, just noting for the

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record in your Protest Letter you referred to the 1 2 Meadowlawn --3 MR. DOWER: Yes. 4 AGENT FLETCHER: -- Meadowlawn 5 Condominium Residential Association. I'm just noting for the record that the association 6 7 doesn't have standing as a protestant, but the 8 Group of Five does. 9 MR. DOWER: Thank you. 10 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. So we have three protestants: A Citizens Association 11 of Georgetown, I'm going to refer to this as the 12 13 Elizabeth Emes group, and ANC-2E are granted 14 standing. The Group of Five represented by 15 Benjamin Dower is granted conditional standing. 16 Four more individuals must appear at the upcoming 17 Status Hearing. 18 We need to set a date for a mediation, 19 a Status Hearing and a Protest Hearing. I'11 20 give you the date for the Status and Protest 21 Hearing first. 22 The Status Hearing is set for January

1 16, 2019 at 9:30. 2 The Protest Hearing is set for February 13, 2019 at 1:30. 3 I'll give you the next available date 4 5 for mediation. Let's see, do you want to --6 well, let's begin with the week of January 7, if 7 that's good for everybody? I know the previous 8 week is right -- is the week of New Year's and 9 some people are not available that week. What about January 10, that's a 10 11 Thursday, January 10 at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 1:00, 12 2:00? 13 MR. MURPHY: January 10 for me first 14 thing in the morning would be best. 15 MS. EMES: It would be better for us 16 later. 17 MR. MURPHY: Okay. Well, I can do it 18 later. 19 This is for the mediation? MS. EMES: This is for the 20 MR. MURPHY: 21 mediation. Okay. 22 AGENT FLETCHER: Do you want to do

1 later? 2 MS. EMES: Later. AGENT FLETCHER: Later is good. 3 So what's later? Like 11:00, 1:00? 4 5 MS. CRUSE: 1:00 is really bad. MS. EMES: Can you do it another time? 6 7 MR. MURPHY: I can do it the morning. 8 AGENT FLETCHER: So we are going to go 9 with early afternoon? 11:00, is that better? 10 MS. EMES: MR. MURPHY: Does that work for you? 11 12 That's fine for me. 13 AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. Elliott, is 11:00 14 good for you? 15 MR. ELLIOTT: Any time that the 16 protestants can agree on is fine with us. 17 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Then the 18 mediation is set for January 10 at 11:00. 19 Mr. Elliott, did you put your contact information on that sheet? 20 21 MR. ELLIOTT: I did. 22 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Did you, Mr.--

1	MR. ELLIOTT: Home phone and email.
2	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, that's perfect.
3	Thank you. You, Mr. Dower? Are you on there
4	already?
5	MR. DOWER: I'll do it right now.
6	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
