ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On November 17, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Wholesaler's Class B License No. ABRA-108879 held by Sankofa Beer Company, LLC, t/a Sankofa Beer Company (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to pay the second-year license fees. *See* Board Order No. 2021-761.

On December 16, 2021, Kofi Meroe., on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Wholesaler's Class B License No. ABRA-108879. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from submitting its second year license fees have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner pays the second-year license fees.

Accordingly, it is this 12th day of January 2022, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on November 17, 2021, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Wholesaler's Class B License No. ABRA-108879 be **REINSTATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
