ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Select Whiskey, LLC, t/a Select Whiskey (Respondent), has failed to pay the second-year license fees for its license by March 31, 2022, the deadline for all Retailer's AI licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the payment date.

On April 20, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against the Respondent pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to pay the second-year license fees for the Retailer's Class AI License. The Respondent did not respond to the Order to Cease and Desist.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that Select Whiskey, LLC's License No. ABRA-117401 is **CANCELLED.** A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.
