ORDER LIFTING CEASE AND DESIST

In a letter, dated January 25, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board notified Sewa’s Conveniency Store, LLC, t/a Sewa's Conveniency Store, (Licensee) holder of a Retailer’s Class B License (ABRA License No. 118877), at 1633 North Capitol Street, N.E., that the Board intended to suspend the license based on the receipt of information that the Licensee’s Basic Business License (BBL) issued by the D.C. Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs (DCRA) had expired, and that the Licensee was no longer eligible to operate a business in the District of Columbia. A cease-and-desist order was issued on March 2, 2022, because the BBL issue had not been corrected. *In re Sewa’s Conveniency Store, LLC, t/a Sewa’s Conveniency Store*, ABRA License No. 118877, Board Order No. 2022-087 (D.C.A.B.C.B. Mar. 2, 2022). Subsequently, on August 10, 2022, the Board received information from DCRA that all outstanding tax and BBL issues have been resolved and a new BBL has been issued. Therefore, the Board, on this 10th day of August 2022, hereby **LIFTS** the cease-and-desist order contained in Board Order No. 2022-087 and authorizes the return of the license to the Licensee. A copy of this Order shall be provided to the Licensee.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
