ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA) has reviewed its records and determined that Naomi's Ladder II, LLC, t/a Smokin' Pig's (Licensee), Safekeeping was granted through September 30, 2024. The Safekeeping fee was scheduled to be paid within thirty (30) days from the date of the Safekeeping approval.

The ABCA's Licensing Division provided a written notice, dated February 14, 2024, and a reminder on March 13, 2024, to the Licensee notifying the Licensee that the Safekeeping fee was due within thirty (30) days and failure to pay the safekeeping fee will result in cancellation of the license. However, the Licensee failed to pay its Safekeeping fee.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 3rd day of April 2024 that Naomi's Ladder II, LLC's License No. ABRA-104866 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
