14	would just state it and spell it for the record.
15	MR. ROUNTREE: David Rountree, it's D-A-V-
16	I-D R-O-U-N-T-R-E-E.
17	MS. FLETCHER: R-O-U-N -
18	MR. ROUNTREE: T-R-E-E.
19	MS. FLETCHER: Oh, Rountree. Thank you.
20	And present of behalf of ANC 6B?
21	MR. JAYARAMAN: Chander Jayaraman, C-H-A-
22	N-D-E-R, last name, J-A-Y-A-R-A-M-A-N.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Jayaraman. 2 ANC 6B has standing as a protestant. We need to set a date for a Status Hearing, a Protest Hearing, and a 3 4 Mediation. 5 I'll give you the dates for the Status and The Status Hearing is Protest Hearing first. 6 scheduled for August 7 at 9:30 a.m., that's August 7th 7 at 9:30 a.m. for the Status Hearing. 8 9 MR. JAYARAMAN: Would you delay that 10 ma'am? 11 MS. FLETCHER: What we can do, Mr. 12 Jayaraman, is I'll give you that date, because that's 13 the next available date on the Board's calendar. But 14 you can ask the Board to reschedule it through Martha 15 Jenkins. You know Martha Jenkins? 16 MR. JAYARAMAN: Got it, yes. 17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Then how about 22 Although we don't meet in MR. JAYARAMAN:
