ORDER APPROVING OFFER IN COMPROMISE

The above-mentioned parties appeared before the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) for a Show Cause hearing scheduled for April 9, 2025. At the hearing, the parties proposed an offer-in-compromise (OIC) to resolve the enforcement action described in Case No. 24-CMP-00066. The Board approved the OIC at the hearing.

ORDER

Therefore, on this 9th day of April 2025, the Board **APPROVES** the OIC presented by the parties. The terms of the OIC are as follows:

1. The Respondent shall pay a fine of \$250 for the violation described in Charge I (D.C. Code § 25-823(a)(6)).

2. The Respondent shall receive a **WARNING** for the violation described by Charge II (D.C. Code § 25-823(a)(1)).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent must pay the fine within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of this Order, or its license shall be immediately suspended until all amounts owed are paid.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, in accordance with 23 DCMR § 800.1, the violation found by the Board in this Order shall be deemed a secondary tier offense for both charges.

A copy of this Order shall be provided to the parties.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 899 North Capitol Street, N.E., Suite 4200-B, Washington, DC 20002.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202-879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
